## Unconventional Season

The Political Parties' Parties Haven't Gone As Planned. By Ryan A. Berenz

The Democratic and Republican National Conventions were supposed to take place with all the pomp, circumstance and spectacle for which these massive events are famous. But this is 2020, and COVID-19 has rudely tossed "supposed to" out the door.

The scaled-back DNC will now take place Aug. 17-20 in Milwaukee and include virtual events and smaller gatherings in different cities. Delegates won't make the trip and will instead remotely cast their votes. Joe Biden is still expected to accept the nomination in Milwaukee, but it will look and feel far different from anything in the past. "Like so much of life these days, it will be mostly a Zoom show," says FOX News election co-anchor Martha MacCallum. "Trying to generate that same punch online and with social distancing among those who are there will likely deflate some of the air from the balloons that are always the big finish."

The RNC will conduct its official business in Charlotte, N.C., Aug. 21-24, then head to Jacksonville, Fla., Aug. 24-27 for the traditional rallies, celebrations and Donald Trump's speech accepting his party's bid for reelection. "Despite all the

plans of the RNC to move from Charlotte to Jacksonville to get that big party atmosphere, COVID-19 will have a vote and will likely dictate what each convention looks like," says Bret Baier, MacCallum's co-anchor on the FOX News election desk.

Covering these conventions poses new challenges for CNN, FOX News and MSNBC. *The Wall Street Journal* reported that the major news networks were in discussions to share resources and reduce the overall number of journalists, staff and crew attending the events in person.

The success or failure of the 2020 conventions could also force the parties to reevaluate how much money and resources to put toward future gatherings. "For years the discussion has been that conventions merely ratify a foregone conclusion and are perhaps not necessary," MacCallum says. "This summer we will find out."

"Expect things to look a lot different and the challenge will be for the organizers to still create excitement in the presentation," Baier says. "There are big issues that we're facing as a country. Those issues will be front and center at both conventions – no matter what they look like."

# 5 Questions

With **RANDY FENOLI** of  
TLC's "Say Yes To The Dress" By Barb Oates

If there's one thing fashion designer and host of TLC's *Say Yes to the Dress* Randy Fenoli can offer during these more uncertain times, it's his inspiration and upbeat outlook that finds the beauty in every person he encounters. While wedding season looks a lot different this year, *Say Yes to the Dress* (Saturdays) shot the new season prior to shutdowns so there's plenty of much-missed drama to fill your time. Here Randy answers our "5 Questions."

## 1 Do you have a favorite episode this season that you're really excited about?

There are a couple of moments that were the most exciting for me personally. One was when they called me downstairs for a fitting, which is kind of rare. I walked in and the bride is standing in my dress, but it's the first style I ever put down the runway, Style 101, that I designed back in 1993. Her mother bought the dress from me at a trunk show that I did at Kleinfeld back in 1993 and wore the dress on her wedding day. And now her daughter was wearing it for the ceremony. It was one of the most unbelievable feelings of my life, just to see one of my original designs being used again by a bride. It was really touching.

## 2 What's a typical fan encounter like for you?

They become more and more crazy. I have to tell you, it's hard to leave the house anymore. Even with my mask on, they still recognize me. I have a home down in Florida, and literally one day ... a couple years ago, I was driving through the drive-thru at Wendy's [short on time as he prepped for a hurricane] and placed my order, got up to the window, and there were six people hanging out the window. She goes, "I told you, I could tell by his voice."

## 3 What's a movie you never get tired of watching?

Oh God, there's probably a dozen. I am a movie fanatic. I love *Moulin Rouge!* ... *The Hunger Games* ... *The Matrix* ... 9 to 5. Comedies. *Steel Magnolias*. *The Perks of Being a Wallflower*. Anything with Jennifer Lawrence. *Passengers*.

## 4 What are three shows you recently watched or binged that you enjoyed?

Basically anything on the Food Network I love. If I don't have the news on all day long, I usually have the Food Network on all day long because I love to cook – I used to be a personal chef.

## 5 What are three things you always have to have in your fridge or pantry?

Definitely my espresso. Water. I drink probably 12 to 14 glasses a day. Let me look right now, what I have. I always have eggs. Tomatoes and vinegar. I love sour and salty.

### MOVING TO A NEW HOME

**Cobra Kai** is moving from YouTube to Netflix for its third season. The series stars Ralph Macchio and ① William Zabka, and the new deal also includes adding the first two seasons to the streaming service and rebranding the show as a "Netflix original." YouTube is moving away from airing scripted shows. ... ② British drama

**Gangs of London** has been picked up for a second season and will air on AMC. The 10-part series was a hit in the U.K. and follows the rise of international gangs after a powerful figure is assassinated. The show's first season will air on AMC in the fall, and the second season is expected in 2022.



### NEWS AT NBC

NBC is adapting British game show **Small Fortune** with host ③ Lil Rel Howery, who will also serve as executive producer. In the series, teams of three friends compete in tiny challenges to win big money. Each challenge takes dexterity and skill, and there's no room for error when everything is so small, but the cash prize will make it



all worth it. ... A pilot NBC is pursuing for 2021 is **La Brea**, about a massive sinkhole that opens up in Los Angeles and separates a mother and son from a father and daughter with a new, primeval world. NBC is looking to possibly pick up the show with a straight-to-series order. ... NBC has also picked up **Connecting**, an eight-episode comedy taking place in this new coronavirus world. The show comes from **Blindspot** creator ④ Martin Gero and showcases a group of friends trying to stay connected via video chat as they share what's going on in their lives.

### TWO NEW SERIES

ABC has ordered **Big Sky** straight to series, created by David E. Kelley. Kelley also wrote the story, which is a procedural following private detective Cassie Dewell, who partners with ex-cop Jenny Hoyt to hunt down two kidnapped sisters in Montana. Soon they discover more women have disappeared, and it's a race against the clock to find the kidnapper before it's too late. ... Comedy Central has ordered a new animated series, **Jodie**, a ⑤ spinoff of the iconic MTV series **Daria**. The show will follow one of Daria's friends from the original show, Jodie, as she graduates from college and looks for a job. Jodie will be voiced by *black-ish*'s Tracee Ellis Ross, who will also executive produce.





### How To Set Parental Controls

If you've ever had an unexpected movie-rental charge on your DISH bill, or if you've ever caught your kids watching something inappropriate for their age, you may want to consider setting up parental controls. These options allow you to establish control over what programming and channels are accessible to everyone in your home.

#### To access parental controls on your Hopper, Joey or Wally:

- Press the **Home** button twice on your remote control.  
Or press the **Menu** button once if you have the 40.0 model.
- Select the **Settings** tile
- Choose the **Parental Controls** tile
- Select **Parental Controls** and choose the **On** option
- Enter a four-digit code that you will remember
  - While parental controls are on, this passcode must be entered when accessing restricted video content, channels or apps
- Select your desired controls from the options onscreen
  - You can restrict purchases, hide adult programs, lock certain channels and more
- When you are done, press and hold the **Back/Live TV** button to go back to live TV

#### Parental controls are also available on our ViP receivers:

- Press the **Menu** button on your remote control
- Select **Locks**
- Select the parental control you want to edit
- Once complete, select **Lock System**




# TCM's summer under the **STARS**

There's something about Goldie Hawn that's always made us smile. Her upbeat attitude, free spirit and genuine, kindhearted nature have radiated both onscreen and off. A few of you may first remember the bubbly, blond starlet in CBS' one-season run of *Good Morning World* as gossipy neighbor Sandy; however, it was her turn on *Rowan & Martin's Laugh-In* (that body paint, that bikini, that ditzzy bombshell!) that will forever be etched in our minds. Hawn's career has spanned five decades and here we celebrate her, now 74, by looking at a handful of the films that are part of her TCM lineup on Sunday, Aug. 9, and sharing some of the stories that have made her one of Hollywood's most golden gems.

# Goldie Hawn Is One Of 12 First-Timers To Make TCM's Summer Under The Stars Lineup.

## CACTUS FLOWER (1969)

At just 24, Hawn won a Best Supporting Actress Oscar for her role as the troubled mistress to a middle-aged dentist (Walter Matthau) in *Cactus Flower*. During the 42nd Annual Academy Awards, when presenter Fred Astaire read Hawn's name as the winner, an overly excited Raquel Welch ran out on the stage to accept the award on Hawn's behalf, as she was in London filming. Later, Hawn shared her story with her daughter, Kate Hudson, in a feature piece for *Interview* magazine. "I was in bed. I forgot it was on television," she said. "I just went to bed because I had a job to do. I forgot. And you know what? I'm really happy about that. And then my mom and dad called, and they were crying and happy and so proud of their daughter. And that made me cry."



## SWING SHIFT (1984)

Hawn and her partner in life, Kurt Russell, met and fell in love on the set of this 1984 romantic war film. While Hawn was a trained dancer in real life, Russell was not and needed some help to bolster his moves, so he invited Hawn to the Playboy Club, thinking they could practice dancing. The two never made it to the dance floor and instead spent hours just talking and being mesmerized with one another, a romantic spark that hasn't stopped since.



## FOUL PLAY (1978) & SEEMS LIKE OLD TIMES (1980)

The timeless comedy thriller *Foul Play* has Hawn playing the wide-eyed, kindhearted, nitwit librarian Gloria, who gets wrapped up with a reckless detective (Chevy Chase). The film was the first hit for Hawn since her role in 1975's *Shampoo*, and was also said to be the role that secured her future part in 1980's *Private Benjamin*. Hawn re-teamed with Chase two years later in *Seems Like Old Times*, and then reconnected as his first guest on his short-lived talker *The Chevy Chase Show*, where she serenaded him and they celebrated her son Oliver's 17th birthday. "When I had children, that to me was the most important thing that I could ever do," Hawn shared. "I remember when my first son was born and I looked at him and I said, 'I waited so long for you.' And nothing really is going to come between me and my children, and that's a promise I made to them the first time I laid eyes on them."



## THE FIRST WIVES CLUB (1996)

This 1996 starrer – and a premiere on TCM this month – paired Hawn with Diane Keaton and Bette Midler. "For *First Wives*, we all took a cut in our salary, we all took a cut in our back end. Because the studios were never sanguine on trusting that women carrying a movie would actually work," Hawn told *Harper's Bazaar* in a 2017 interview. "You think you're going to prove to Hollywood when you hit 45 that you're still a sexy, viable object? No. There's a certain reality. Does it make me angry? No. I'm not an angry person. I'm not a militant person. Anger doesn't get you anywhere. It's not productive." Instead, these ladies proved their staying power with the movie ranking in the Top 10 films of 1996.

# A "SUMMER" OF FIRSTS

TCM Welcomes Several New Stars And Movies  
To Summer Under The Stars 2020. By Jeff Pfeiffer

**B**esides Goldie Hawn on Aug. 9 (see previous spread), a number of other famed – and some perhaps less-well-known but still influential – Hollywood personalities will be spotlighted for the first time during TCM's Summer Under the Stars celebration in 2020. Here are a few of this year's other notable SUTS first-timers (check the daily listings for a complete list of titles each day):

## S.Z. "CUDDLES" SAKALL (AUG. 4)

His name may not be especially familiar, but the Hungarian-born Sakall's face is quite recognizable from his numerous appearances as a supporting character actor throughout films of Hollywood's golden age. That face of his sported such a rotund cuteness that legendary studio head Jack Warner gave the actor the nickname of "Cuddles." Sakall may not have carried any film or even had much screen time in it, but he made the most of his roles, as can be seen in his Summer Under the Stars lineup of movies, including *The Daughter of Rosie O'Grady* (1950), *In the Good Old Summertime* (1949), *Christmas in Connecticut* (1945), *Lullaby of Broadway* (1951), *The Student Prince* (1954, his final film role) and more.



## JOHN BARRYMORE (AUG. 13)



It's interesting that TCM has not, to this point, given this noted member of the famed Barrymore acting family his own SUTS day,

but that changes this month. Featured today will be a few Barrymore classics from the silent era, including *Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde* (1920), *Don Juan* (1926) and *When a Man Loves* (1927), as well as beloved "talkies" like *Grand Hotel* (1932), *Dinner at Eight* (1933), the network premiere of *Night Club Scandal* (1937) and one of Barrymore's last films, *The Great Man Votes* (1939).

## SAMMY DAVIS JR. (AUG. 11)

The talents of legendary singer/dancer/actor Sammy Davis Jr. will be on full display in his debut SUTS celebration. The lineup will, of course, feature Rat Pack

classics like *Ocean's 11* (1960) and *Robin and the 7 Hoods* (1964). But other films will also be spotlighted, including Davis' feature film debut in 1933's *Rufus Jones for President*, as well as the network premieres of the 1983 Jerry Lewis film *Cracking Up* (a.k.a. *Smorgasbord*), in which Davis appeared as himself; and *Tap* (1989), Davis' final feature film, in which he costarred with Gregory Hines and showed off his still-formidable tap-dancing skills.



## PAUL HENREID (AUG. 28)



The Austrian-born Henreid's iconic appearance as Victor Laszlo in the 1942 classic *Casablanca*

will, of course, be one of the films featured on his SUTS day. Also on that day's lineup are Henreid's memorable roles in *Of Human Bondage* (1946), *Now, Voyager* (1942), the network premiere of *For Men Only* (1952) and more.

# FRAN DRESCHER IN MY OWN WORDS

How "The Nanny" Star Survived The Toughest Tests Of Life And Hollywood.

By Ryan A. Berenz

From her earliest work in movies like *Saturday Night Fever* and *American Hot Wax* in the late 1970s, to her tour de force sitcom *The Nanny* in the '90s, and 21st-century projects like *Living With Fran* and *Happily Divorced*, Fran Drescher is a survivor in an often unforgiving business.

She's also overcome a lot in her personal life, from being the victim of a violent crime in 1985, to a bitter divorce in 1999 and a uterine cancer diagnosis shortly thereafter.

"Bad things happen to good people, but what we do with it, how we grow through it and what becomes of us as human beings is what makes all the difference," Drescher says. In 2007, she founded the Cancer Schmancer Movement ([cancerschmancer.org](http://cancerschmancer.org)) and charitable foundation. "I got famous, I got cancer and I lived to talk about it," she says. "So I leverage my fame for the greater good always."

Drescher talked with us about having her life and career explored in an

Aug. 16 episode of REELZChannel's *In My Own Words* series.

### On her parents being interviewed for *In My Own Words*:

**Fran Drescher:** My parents have been satellite celebrities since I became famous. And they're very outgoing, comfortable-in-their-own-skin people anyways. They've worked for me as actors in many of my projects. They've appeared on talk shows like *Rosie* and my show, *The Fran Drescher Show*. I was so glad that they felt well enough to do it. And for posterity, to have that. I asked for all the footage that they did because [filmmaker Bill Katz] talked to them for hours, and I want to have it all. And for me, that alone was worth doing it.

### On being first runner-up in the 1973 Miss New York Teenager pageant:

I was on my own path, my own trajectory, and I had such a clear focus at a very young age that I just used the contest


as a stepping-stone to try and move into becoming a professional. I remember even telling my parents that I didn't want them to spend the money on driver education so I could drive like a year younger because I'd rather use that money to get a headshot.

### On almost giving up on showbiz in the 1980s:

I remember I did a pilot that I was really miserable doing. I thought that it was beneath me, not good enough. I was playing like a third banana, the neighbor, an overtly sexy, very two-dimensional character. And it just wasn't satisfying to me. I've always had a very high-set bar for my own level of personal contentment and happiness. I always felt like I can make money a million different ways. And even though I enjoy acting, I don't enjoy being in a situation where I'm not able to really accelerate, and having my wings clipped, and being underestimated in what my contribution should be. And for all those reasons, I gave myself five years

to get on the inside in a big way, and be in control of my own destiny, or get out and do something else.

**On living in the now:**

You have to practice understanding and playing the hand that's been dealt you, figuring it out instead of being cemented into, "This wasn't what was supposed to be." And then you start to get a little more fluid. I hate to use the word "plastic," but that's a word that people use a lot. To be able to have a flexibility, to know that we're all just candles blowing in the wind and we're not in control. We really don't know what the future is going to bring. So you start to cultivate an appreciation for the now. You keep realizing, "Oh, wow, look how blessed we are to even be sitting here right now."

# Bo Derek

## IN MY OWN WORDS

Still Smiling After All These Years. By Paul Hall

After finishing a call with her farrier (that's the craftsman who trims and shoes her horses), Bo Derek ran into her California house and got on the phone to chat with us about her upcoming episode of the REELZChannel premiere docuseries *In My Own Words*.



As her three German shepherds Chico, Luke and Smokey said hi in the background – as part of a game created by her longtime boyfriend John Corbett – Bo laughed about it, admitting it was just a bit of a distraction, before opening up about what it was like to get the chance to finally tell her own story.

“I just watched it yesterday,” Bo says of the documentary. “I put it off until the last minute, because I’m very uncomfortable with this idea. I finally watched it yesterday. I found it really interesting.”

Knowing Bo is an extremely private individual, we found the documentary equally as fascinating as the superstar. In the film, those who know her take us on a little-known journey of her life.

“It was a leap of faith, I have to say,” she adds. “It’s rare that you get to tell your story in your own words. I’ve been in the business now forever, and I’ve never been given this opportunity. I usually don’t take part because you feel you’re just adding more fuel to whatever bomb they want to build and drop on you and your reputation. ... sometimes I’ve participated because maybe I’ll diffuse some of the negativity, but in this case, I talked with Bill [Katz, the series director] and although it was a leap of faith, I just felt I could trust him. I’m not saying I controlled all of it and that I made it exactly the way I would have told my story, but I just saw the cut yesterday and I’m not going to change a thing. I think we all have in our backgrounds decisions we made or situations that make us cringe a little. And I certainly have some of those; no regrets, but I’m really pleased.”

The film weaves together her life, starting with her high school days (she left school at age 16) and her family dynamics (her father was a Hobie Cat executive and her mother worked for Ann-Margret). She shared with us how she got her first peek into celebrity life.

“My mother and father were friends with Ann-Margret and her husband, Roger Smith. They went on trips together. They were very close,” she tells. “Then when my parents separated and divorced, Ann-Margret was incredibly generous and gave my mother an opportunity to come and work for her as her hairdresser. So my mom went and earned her license in cosmetology school and then went to work for her as her hairdresser.”

Bo was just a teenager when she was discovered and traveled to Greece with director John Derek. An exotic locale with a heartthrob director led to the two falling in love and a 22-year marriage. Bo didn’t plan it that way, but Linda Evans, John’s wife at the time, knew this was more than just an infatuation. There is a touching moment in the documentary with Evans that left Bo almost speechless.

“God, that just really floored me. I didn’t know they had asked to interview her about me for this piece, and I didn’t think she would do it,” Bo says. “To see that – it was very emotional for me and very difficult to watch her. She’s so honest

and opens up. That was pretty incredible. It really took me by surprise. ... She’s a very private person and I didn’t expect that at all. It really, really affected me.”

After John died in 1998, Bo admits it completely derailed her. “There were five years where I didn’t even date. Not because I told myself, ‘Oh, there was only one man for me.’ I was open to it, but the sparks didn’t fly.”

Of course the episode also explores her life-changing role in 1979’s *10*, the film with which her name has become synonymous. Bo’s first press conference for the movie holds some intrigue, and she shares how different times are today with actresses and how much more prepared they are for media.

“I didn’t ever even fantasize being famous or being the subject of a press conference like that, a big one,” she says

about the segment. “So I wasn’t even, in my imagination, prepared. Whereas today, most actors are groomed and are prepared. They have publicists, they have agents, they’re in their mind prepared for these things. They want them. I really wasn’t. I just came onto the scene accidentally. I didn’t have an agent. I didn’t have a lawyer, a publicist and the entourage that normally goes with an actor. So I was completely blindsided by it all. And now with social media, and I look at young people and they are camera savvy. You never hear that expression, ‘camera shy,’ or [being] uncomfortable in front of a camera anymore. They’re prepared.”

Now Bo is proving to live a “10”-level life. Her Twitter feed @boderek – yes, she has dipped into social media – is filled with positive stories about animals, BoDerekPetCare.com and her other charitable work.

Bo summed things up quite well about her life and current views: “I’m not on a mission to change people’s minds or be remembered for anything. I think the older I get, what matters is how good a friend I’ve been to people I care about.”

# UNITED WE FALL

"Saturday Night Live's" Jane Curtin And  
"Scandal's" Guillermo Diaz Add Some Punch  
To ABC's New Comedy. By Damian Holbrook



**ABC**'s latest family comedy traverses the ins and outs of dealing with in-laws – and the ties that bind when they start to get seriously tangled. In fact, put-upon parents Bill and Jo (Will Sasso and Christina Vidal Mitchell) are struggling to raise their two daughters under the same roof as his mother, Sandy (*Saturday Night Live* icon Jane Curtin), who has recently moved in. Could Jo's super-opinionated brother and business partner, Chuy (*Scandal*'s Guillermo Diaz), actually make things easier for the stressed couple? We'll see.

"Rounding out the family is always fun in a sitcom. You get to develop the chemistry between these characters, and it's been [great] to play," Sasso (*MADtv*) says.

Fittingly, the July 29 episode is all about playing *and* family dynamics. Worried that their eldest, iPad-dependent Emily (Ella Grace Helton), is too plugged in, Bill and Jo decide to enroll her in a soccer clinic run by Chuy. "I love what Guillermo Diaz is doing with Chuy for a lot of reasons, but one of them definitely is the character itself, of the oldest brother, who of course is going to be the most domineering attitude ... as a character," Sasso adds. "Chuy's a great guy and has all the answers, even though he doesn't have any of the answers."

Not that Bill's side of the family is any less overbearing. With matriarch Sandy installed in their home, Bill and Jo are subjected to an endless parade of unwelcome parenting tips, which turn into hilarious pile-ons once Sandy gets together with Chuy. Sasso, laughing, describes that relationship as one "based completely on them telling Bill and Jo what to do. I would say they have a mad crush on each other because they're so excited by the other's ability to break down Bill and Jo."

Still, Sasso adds, this husband-and-wife duo stand, as the title notes, united against the constant slings and arrows of their ultimately well-intentioned relatives. "That's really something I loved about the script right away," the comedy veteran says. "These two are on the same team. It's not one of those shows where it's like, 'Oh, I've got to deal with this [bleep] again!'"

## THE **Their Lips Are No Longer Sealed** GO-GO'S

The '80s Music Pioneers  
Unseal Their Story In  
Showtime Doc. By Ryan A. Berenz

Known for quintessential '80s hits like "We Got the Beat" and "Our Lips Are Sealed," the Go-Go's remain the only all-female band who wrote their own songs and played their own instruments to have a No. 1 album on the Billboard charts.

Born in 1978 in the anything-goes L.A. punk rock scene, the Go-Go's were rough and raw misfit musicians performing in underground clubs. But the band got its spark when guitarist Charlotte Caffey – inspired during a midnight viewing of *The Twilight Zone* – wrote "We Got the Beat" in five minutes. The pop-punk hybrid gave the Go-Go's the hook they needed, and soon after they toured in England with Madness and the Specials, and they signed a record deal with Miles Copeland's I.R.S. Records. Their videos became fixtures on the burgeoning MTV, and the band's 1981 debut album, *Beauty and the Beat*, reached No. 1 and stayed there for six weeks.

But the Go-Go's couldn't avoid the classic *Behind the Music* career arc. Commercial success led to tensions and infighting among members, further exacerbated by drug use, hard partying, creative differences and an exhausting touring schedule. The Go-Go's acrimoniously broke up in 1985.

Director Alison Ellwood's documentary film *The Go-Go's* features the band's full participation, and a wealth of archival video, photos, music and interviews reveals the inside story of a group that opened the music industry's eyes.

## Seeking The Human Stories Behind The Devastating Fallout From The First Atomic Bomb. By Jeff Pfeiffer

This month, the world will gravely commemorate the 75th anniversary of the first detonation of a nuclear weapon in wartime, which occurred on Aug. 6, 1945, when the United States dropped an atomic bomb on the Japanese city of Hiroshima. A second bomb was dropped on the city of Nagasaki three days later. The bombings accelerated Japan's surrender and the end of World War II, but at a terrible human cost — well over 100,000 people, mostly civilians, were immediately killed in the vaporized cities, while survivors were horribly maimed and/or inflicted with burns and radiation poisoning.

History Channel marks this somber event with the two-hour documentary *Hiroshima: 75 Years Later* from award-winning director James Erskine, which aims to infuse some humanity in one of our species' darkest moments by allowing the figures who designed, built and detonated the bomb, as well as those who were caught in its wake, to narrate their own journeys through an astonishing story of scientific endeavor, unprecedented ambition and unyielding horror.

Told entirely from the first-person perspective of leaders, physicists, soldiers and survivors, the film uses never-before-seen archival footage, long-suppressed color film from the immediate aftermath of the bomb and audio testimony from victims to provide a highly personal understanding of the event, and to present the moral, scientific and military conundrums of the atomic bomb as felt by those closest to it.

## Things Get Crazy This Year With Mike Tyson Taking On The Tiger Shark.

There's no denying you live on the edge of the extreme if you are comfortable diving with sharks. This year Discovery Channel is promising a robust lineup (over 20 hours!) of fun programming for its 32nd annual Shark Week, which begins Sunday, Aug. 9. The weeklong stunt started in 1988 and continues to be TV's longest-running event in history. So nothing is going to stop the network from airing its famed Shark Week – not even a worldwide pandemic. # EARTHFLIGHT

A Bird's-Eye View

## Stunning BBC Doc Offers A Bird's-Eye View Of The World. By Jeff Pfeiffer

It's no secret by now that the BBC is the gold standard when it comes to producing nature documentaries for television. A combination of scientific expertise, technical advances in camerawork, and the incredible patience and professionalism displayed by the filmmakers in sometimes waiting months or longer to capture rare or previously unseen wildlife behavior has yielded stunning, enjoyable and important series like *Planet Earth* and *The Blue Planet*.

It's common for these series, when they air in America, to be edited in some ways and to feature different narrators. That was the case with BBC's *Earthflight*, an amazing 2011 docuseries narrated by David Tennant (*Doctor Who*, *Good Omens*) that takes a bird's-eye view of our feathered friends in flight across six continents. The series previously aired in the U.S. in 2012 on Discovery Channel in an abridged version (two hours instead of the full six) under the title *Winged Planet*; in 2013, the full series did air on PBS, but with a different narrator.

Now, for the first time, U.S. audiences can see the entire *Earthflight* series with its original Tennant narration on BBC America starting this month.

*Earthflight* has lost none of its "wow" factor since its debut nearly a decade ago, using incredible camerawork via drones and microlights – along with having its bird subjects imprint upon a human to keep them close enough for people to film – to fly high with birds as they live their lives and experience some of the greatest natural events on our planet.

The first five episodes focus on specific continents – North America, Africa, Europe, South America, Asia and Australia – while the final episode looks at the technology used to produce those episodes. *Earthflight* consistently and often literally soars, in its images and in its quality.

This Dark Drama Offers A New Take On Death And Mental Illness.



If you like dark and twisty doctors like Meredith Grey, chances are you'll like Dr. Jenny Cooper, the protagonist of *Coroner*, a new show on The CW hailing from Canada (where it's already been renewed for a third season). In the series, Cooper struggles with her mental health while raising her teenage son after the death of her husband. She is played by Serinda Swan, who describes the show as "sort of a *Nurse Jackie* vibe in the sense that it's a really flawed, wonderful lead character."

The series opens with Cooper, a former ER doctor, taking over the job of coroner in Toronto despite struggling with a pill addiction and panic attacks. After suffering a psychotic break, she no longer wants to work with the living, but feels more comfortable among the dead. "Her belief system about herself is that she has a fascination with life, and that's why she tries to save lives," said Swan. "But really, as she starts to work her way through the season, she realizes that it was actually more so to be in proximity of death, because there's something about death and her that are intrinsically connected."

*Coroner* deals with mental health in a different way than most shows, fully immersing the viewer in the intensity of a crisis. Swan is sure to keep this element of Cooper as realistic as possible. "I remember I was doing one of her panic attacks, and they're like, 'We're running long on the episode. Can you make the panic attack shorter?' And I was like, 'I'm really sorry. I can't,'" Swan said. "I'm tough in that sense, where I can't allow somebody who has anxiety to watch us make it easier because we don't have enough time. I don't want somebody with anxiety to feel misrepresented, and I don't want somebody without anxiety to not understand this actual process."

And *Romance in the Air* provides just that grounding we all need right now.



## BUBBLE BALL

The NBA Restarts Its Season In The Most Magical Place On Earth.

The NBA was the first major sports league to suspend its season when the COVID-19 outbreak hit. After a four-month layoff, it's time for the Association to finish what it started.

Basketball resumes July 30 with 22 teams competing in the "bubble" at Disney's ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex in Orlando, Fla. Teams play eight regular-season games each to establish playoff berths and seeding, with a potential play-in tournament if the race for the eighth seed is close. The playoff format remains as usual, with

16 teams competing in best-of-seven-game series beginning with the first round Aug.

17 and continuing with the conference semifinals Aug. 31, conference finals

Sept. 15 and the NBA Finals Sept. 30.

If necessary, Game 7 of the NBA Finals would be Oct. 12. Games air on ABC, ESPN, NBA TV, TNT and regional sports networks.

LeBron James and the L.A. Lakers restart the season on top of the Western Conference standings, followed by the L.A. Clippers, Denver Nuggets, Utah Jazz and Oklahoma City Thunder. In the East, Giannis Antetokounmpo and the Milwaukee Bucks hope to pick up right where they left off after winning a league-leading 53 games before the layoff. Chasing the Bucks are the Toronto Raptors, Boston Celtics, Miami Heat and Indiana Pacers.

Even with an abundance of health and safety protocols in place, it's inevitable that COVID-19 will be a factor in determining the 2020 NBA champion. If a star player or multiple players on a team contract the virus, it could sink a contender's title chances. Several players – including the Lakers' Avery Bradley – are choosing to opt out of playing in Orlando for personal or family reasons, and there will likely be others as the season progresses. It will also be bittersweet for the eventual NBA champion and their fans to win without frenzied home crowds and victory celebrations.
