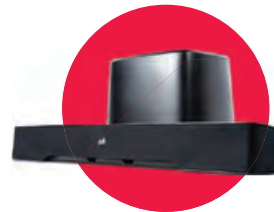

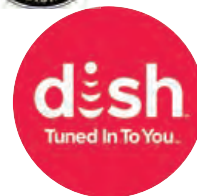

Journeying Into The Unknown

Travel Channel Has Made The Paranormal Its Primary Destination. By Jeff Pfeiffer

If you're a regular viewer of the Travel Channel, you've probably noticed a not-so-subtle change in its programming strategy. The network that once focused on, as its name implies, things like exotic travel spots has turned its schedule over to a lineup of series that are not about vacation horror stories, but *actual* horror stories – featuring ghosts, Bigfoot and other paranormal mysteries.

These programs boast creepy titles like *Portals to Hell*, *Ghost Adventures*, *Ghost Nation*, *Destination Fear*, *Kindred Spirits*, *The Dead Files*, *Expedition Bigfoot*, *Paranormal Caught on Camera* and many others. A new series joins that mix this month – *Hotel Paranormal*, which debuts July 11 and is narrated by *Ghostbusters* cowriter/costar Dan Aykroyd (a real-life paranormal buff himself). The series will feature spine-tingling stories of supernatural encounters people have had at hotels of various types.

Unlike the subjects that programs like this investigate, there's not much of a mystery behind why Travel changed its itinerary in

this way starting in 2018 – people love these shows.

"Travel Channel had its highest-rated year ever in 2019," says Matthew Butler, general manager of the network. "Our audience can't get enough of this content – they have an insatiable desire to investigate the unknown."

"While [we] may not be programming travel content in the way that we used to, we've always remained true to our mission of providing content that encompasses exploration and adventure, passionate hosts, and great storytelling."

Butler promises that the remainder of this year will feature more of that; notably, October 2020 will see the return of the channel's popular, monthlong "Ghostober" programming event that began in 2018.

"And it's not all scary," he adds, "because we know our viewers also like to have fun. Audiences can look forward to exciting and entertaining new content that expands on the [paranormal] genre in a fun, new way."

5 Questions

With **ADAM SCOTT**, Host Of
ABC's New Game Show "Don't" By Taylor Neumann

In this time of uncertainty and confusion, it can be hard to do anything at all. In fact, it might be easier to do ... nothing? That's the point of ABC's new game show *Don't*, airing Thursdays. Contestants earn money — up to \$100,000 — by *not* doing different actions. For instance, one segment is called "Don't Blink," where players lose money from their bank each time they blink. Oh, but did we mention a fan is blowing in their face?

This crazy idea for a game show comes from the mind of Ryan Reynolds, who recruited Adam Scott (*Parks and Recreation*) to host. "It's the sort of thing I never for a second saw myself doing," explained Scott. "Honestly, when it came across my desk, my first reaction was just a quick 'No.' ... But the fact that Ryan was involved, and the thought that what they had in mind was sort of a meta, kind of self-aware game show — a game show that was acutely aware of how ridiculous it is. And so, it just went from there, and it was a great experience."

With *Don't* airing all month, we decided it was a perfect time to ask Scott our "5 Questions."

1 If your TV could only have three shows, what would they be?

The West Wing, *Watchmen* and Rachel Maddow.

2 What are three things you need to have in your fridge or pantry?

I need sparkling water. I don't mind a flavor at all; I'll take a watermelon or a lemon lime or grapefruit. But I like bubbles in the water that I drink. It makes it twice as interesting. [Also] peanut butter. [And] apples. Ice cold apples. It goes with the peanut butter.

3 What movie can you watch over and over again?

Midnight Run, [with] Robert De Niro and Charles Grodin. I never get sick of that. Or *Raiders of the Lost Ark*.

4 Have you ever been starstruck?

Absolutely, and it's something I wish I could get over, but it's hard for me. I still fumble over myself around some people and it's embarrassing. I think around peers, I'm fine. But when I find myself talking to Meryl Streep, I'm never going to remain cool. It's just impossible.

5 If you weren't an actor, what would you be doing?

I'd like to think I could find my way towards journalism. I don't know if I have the skill as a writer, but I love really good political journalism — it's thrilling to read. And rock 'n' roll journalism or music journalism is sort of a lost art. So, one of those, in a parallel life, I fantasize about.

They're Back, Baby!:

Recently Renewed Shows

CBS recently announced that it has renewed 23 shows — 80% of its top-rated lineup — for the 2020-21 season: all three series in the **NCIS** franchise; both series in the **FBI** franchise; established dramas **Blue Bloods**, **MacGyver**, **Bull**, **Magnum P.I.**, **S.W.A.T.** and **SEAL Team**; established comedies **Young Sheldon**, **Mom** and **The Neighborhood**; reality staples **Survivor**, **The Amazing Race** and **Undercover Boss**; news programs **60 Minutes** and **48 Hours**; new dramas **Evil** and **All Rise**; and new comedies **Bob (Hearts) Abishola** and **The Unicorn**. ... **Forensic Files II**, HLN's highly rated revival of its classic true-crime docuseries, has been renewed for two more seasons that will encompass 32 episodes. ... NBC's **A Little Late With Lilly Singh** will return for Season 2. ... Also at NBC, the comedy/drama **Good Girls** has been renewed for Season 4. ... FOX has renewed **Last Man Standing** and **The Resident**.

FROM BOOK TO SCREEN

Peaky Blinders creator Steven Knight is adapting Charles Dickens' *Great Expectations* for FX. The project will reunite him with ① **Tom Hardy**, who previously appeared on *Blinders*. Knight also adapted *A Christmas Carol* for the network last year. The series will be six parts and is a joint production with the BBC. ... AMC has acquired the rights to ② **Anne Rice's** two biggest book series, *The Vampire Chronicles* and *The Lives of the Mayfair Witches*, made up of 18 titles

total. The deal includes the plan to adapt the material for both broadcast television and streaming, and both Rice and her son Christopher Rice will serve as executive producers on all series and films.

FROM NETFLIX

③ **Bill Skarsgård**, who is probably most well known for playing Pennywise the clown in the recent *It* movies, will now play Swedish criminal Clark Olofsson in a six-part Netflix series, *Clark*. It's a Swedish-language adaptation of the infamous bank robber's memoir,

which detailed his crimes. Skarsgård said of the project, "Clark Olofsson is, for good and bad, one of Sweden's most colorful and fascinating individuals. I accept this challenge with delight mingled with terror." ... Netflix is also adapting the latest novel by author Elena Ferrante, *The Lying Life of Adults*. The novel was released in Italy last November and will release in the United States this September. Ferrante's novels were previously adapted in the series *My Brilliant Friend*. ... Finally, the streamer has also picked up *Sweet Tooth*, a drama based on characters from DC Vertigo comics. The series comes from the producing pair of ④ **Robert Downey Jr. and wife Susan Downey**, and will feature James Brolin as the voice of the narrator.

SERIES ORDERS

Clarice – the thriller series about *The Silence of the Lambs*' Clarice Starling (previously reported in this column) – has been given a series order from CBS, and with that comes some casting news: Kal Penn (*Sunnyside*) and Michael Cudlitz (*The Kids Are Alright*) have taken roles on the show as fellow agents at the FBI. The starring role of Starling herself will be played by ⑤ **Rebecca Breeds**. ... The CW gave series orders to two new shows, *Kung Fu* and *The Republic of Sarah*. *Kung Fu* follows a young Chinese American woman as she drops out of college and decides to go study in a monastery in China. After learning the art of kung fu, she then uses her new skills to protect her hometown and avenge the ones she loves. *The Republic of Sarah* features a rebellious high school teacher who, when her town is taken over by a greedy mining company, uses obscure rules to declare independence for the land and leads a group of young people in starting a new country.



YANKED!: Recently Canceled Shows

CBS was busy canceling stuff: There's no second season for Patricia Heaton's *Carol's Second Act*. Season 2 is a no-go for Pauley Perrette's *Broke*, Edie Falco's *Tommy* turned in its badge after Season 1 and Matt LeBlanc's *Man With a Plan* is a sitcom without a fifth season. ... History made two of its original dramas history: There's no Season 3 for

Knightfall or *Project Blue Book*. ... USA Network has dumped *Dare Me*, cast away *Treadstone* and purged *The Purge* from its lineup. ... OWN's *Greenleaf* will end after its current fifth season, but a spinoff series is in development.

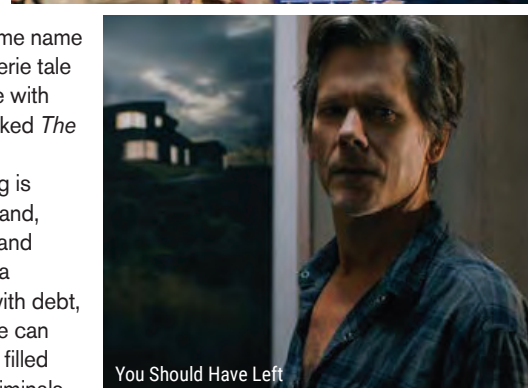

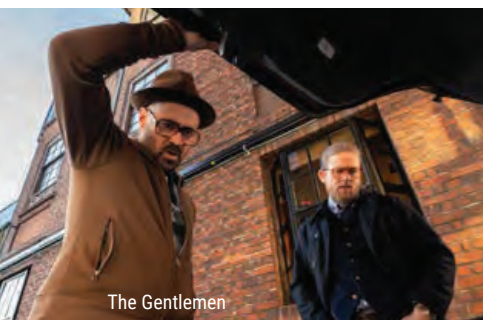

Jaws

1975 – Jaws

Summertime Box Office: \$69.7 million

Steven Spielberg's classic thriller ultimately became the first U.S. film to gross over \$100 million at the box office, with most of its total coming during a summer release that also served to scare many viewers away from beaches that season. *Jaws* was the harbinger of a new blockbuster era; its long lines of eager filmgoers, many of whom saw the film multiple times, showed studios that summertime – before then, considered a largely slow time at theaters – could be big business for movies.

1977 – Star Wars: Episode IV – A New Hope

Summertime Box Office: \$133.7 million

George Lucas' space opera fully established the summer blockbuster era when it exploded onto screens and became a pop-culture phenomenon.

While the recent *Star Wars* films have had Christmas releases, the original trilogy, as well as its prequels, comprised all big-time summer hits like this one: *The Empire Strikes Back* (No. 1, Summer 1980); *Return of the Jedi* (No. 1, Summer 1983); *The Phantom Menace* (No. 1, Summer 1999); *Attack of the Clones* (No. 2, Summer 2002, behind *Spider-Man*); and *Revenge of the Sith* (No. 1, Summer 2005). **Watch the *Star Wars* Original Trilogy and Prequel Trilogy July 19 on TNT.**

1989 – Batman

Summertime Box Office: \$239.2 million

To say Tim Burton's *Batman* was a major pop-culture event in Summer 1989 – with its iconic casting of Michael Keaton and Jack Nicholson, and backed by a Prince soundtrack – is an understatement. The first major big-screen superhero adaptation since 1978's *Superman*, *Batman* launched the initial wave of Caped Crusader feature films, followed by *Batman*

Returns (No. 1, Summer 1992) and *Batman Forever* (No. 1, Summer 1995), before things kind of petered out with 1997's *Batman & Robin* (which still ranked No. 6 that summer). **Watch *Batman*, *Batman Returns*, *Batman Forever* and *Batman & Robin* July 5 on AMC; July 11-12 and July 20 on SundanceTV.**

1996 – *Independence Day*

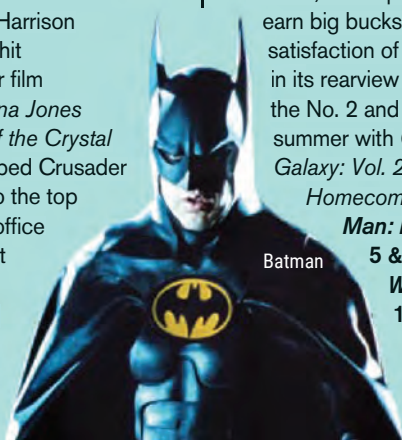
Summertime Box Office: \$282.8 million

This epic alien invasion/disaster film handily beat another disaster film, *Twister*, to conquer the 1996 summer box office. The movie established Will Smith as a bankable leading man, and the actor followed this up in 1997 with another alien-themed No. 1 summer hit, *Men in Black*. The technical advances used in *Independence Day*'s Oscar-winning visual effects to realistically present massive onscreen destruction helped lead to a mini-boom in other similarly effects-driven disaster films, including the 1998 summer blockbusters *Armageddon* (No. 2 that summer) and *Deep Impact* (No. 5). **Watch *Independence Day* July 4 on AMC.**

2008 – *The Dark Knight*

Summertime Box Office: \$506.5 million

In a summer that featured the launch of *The Avengers* franchise with *Iron Man*, and Harrison Ford continuing his hit summer blockbuster film franchise with *Indiana Jones and the Kingdom of the Crystal Skull*, it was the Caped Crusader who again soared to the top of the summer box office and became the first film to eclipse half a billion dollars during

the summer. The film was the second of three Christopher Nolan *Batman* offerings – following *Batman Begins* (No. 5, Summer 2005) and followed by *The Dark Knight Rises* (No. 2, Summer 2012) – and featured the Oscar-winning performance of Heath Ledger as Joker. **Watch *The Dark Knight Rises* July 5-6, 16-17 & 30-31 on AMC.**

2012 – *The Avengers*

Summertime Box Office: \$620.6 million

The Marvel Cinematic Universe (MCU) began in Summer 2008 with *Iron Man*, the No. 3 film that summer, and *The Incredible Hulk* (No. 10). As the MCU grew, its summer hits included *Iron Man 2* (No. 2, Summer 2010) and *Captain America: The First Avenger* (No. 8, Summer 2011). In Summer 2012, the company took a risk by teaming those heroes and others in *The Avengers*, and it paid off. The movie walloped two other comic book films that had not-too-shabby returns that summer: *The Dark Knight Rises* (No. 2) and *The Amazing Spider-Man* (No. 3). **Watch *The Amazing Spider-Man* July 8 & 28-29 on FX.**

2017 – *Wonder Woman*

Summertime Box Office: \$409.8 million

After being regularly owned by Marvel at the box office, DC Comics finally had a No. 1 big-screen summer blockbuster with this film that garnered nearly universally positive reviews and proved to some doubters that a female superhero in a big-budget action film directed by a woman (Patty Jenkins) could pack theaters and

earn big bucks. DC had the added satisfaction of being able to look in its rearview and see Marvel in the No. 2 and No. 3 positions that summer with *Guardians of the Galaxy: Vol. 2* and *Spider-Man: Homecoming*. **Watch *Spider-Man: Homecoming* July 5 & 10 on FX and *Wonder Woman* July 12 on TNT.**

Certain films in particular throughout cinema history have become “feel good” films of this sort, and many of them air regularly on Turner Classic Movies (TCM).

This month, TCM has handpicked a number of these fun and often funny flicks as the focus of its themed TCM Spotlight programming blocks airing each Wednesday night (beginning at 8pm ET).

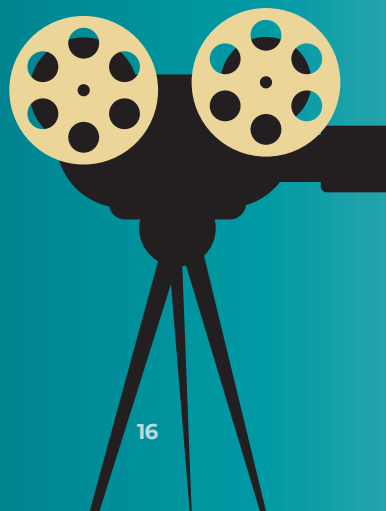


WEDNESDAY, JULY 1 – Theme: “TOE TAPPERS”

As the title implies, you’ll be tapping your toes in no time with a lineup of memorable movie musicals. Some of them are based on stage hits, others are original to the screen, but all of them will lift you up through their singing, dancing and performances. The evening begins with perhaps the most iconic film musical of all time, 1952’s *Singin’ in the Rain*, headlined by Gene Kelly, Debbie Reynolds and Donald O’Connor. This is followed by *Annie* (1982); Fred Astaire and Ginger Rogers in *Top Hat* (1935); *Seven Brides for Seven Brothers* (1954); and *Gigi* (1958).

WEDNESDAY, JULY 8 – Theme: “A GOOD LAUGH”

If you are indeed looking for a good laugh, you can’t do any better than this lineup of iconic film comedies beginning with James Stewart in *Harvey* (1950), followed by Cary Grant and Katharine Hepburn in *Bringing Up Baby* (1938); the Marx Brothers in their funniest film, *A Night at the Opera* (1935); Gene Wilder and Zero Mostel in Mel Brooks’ *The Producers* (1968); Gary Cooper and Jean Arthur in Frank Capra’s *Mr. Deeds Goes to Town* (1936); and Greta Garbo as the title character in Ernst Lubitsch’s *Ninotchka* (1939).





WEDNESDAY, JULY 15 — Theme: **"FAMILY TIES"**

Families of all types figure into this themed lineup of films, which begins with 1958's *Auntie Mame*, and continues with *Meet Me in St. Louis* (1944), *Life With Father* (1947), *The Man Who Came to Dinner* (1942), *On Moonlight Bay* (1951) and *Andy Hardy Gets Spring Fever* (1939).



WEDNESDAY, JULY 29 — Theme: **"GOOD TIME CRIME"**

As TCM ends its Feel-Good Films theme this month, the final programming lineup shows that even stories involving criminal activity can be humorous or enjoyable to movie audiences when the stories are in the right hands. And the stories in tonight's schedule of films certainly are in the right hands of their stars, writers and directors: *The Thin Man* (1934), *Guys and Dolls* (1955), *The Lady Eve* (1941), *Arsenic and Old Lace* (1944) and *Some Like It Hot* (1959).

WEDNESDAY, JULY 22 — Theme: **"LIGHTEARTED LOVE"**

Classic romantic, often screwball, comedies are the focus, kicking off with Margaret Sullivan and James Stewart in *The Shop Around the Corner* (1940), and continuing with Audrey Hepburn and Rex Harrison in the musical comedy *My Fair Lady* (1964); Cary Grant and Rosalind Russell in *His Girl Friday* (1940); Jane Fonda, Rod Taylor and Cliff Robertson in *Sunday in New York* (1963); and *It Happened One Night* (1934), Frank Capra's 1934 masterpiece starring Clark Gable and Claudette Colbert, which established many rom-com tropes and was the first of a select group of films to have ever won all five major Oscar categories.

TOUGH AS NAILS

A New Competition Series For Working-Class Heroes. By Ryan A. Berenz

Essential workers. Everyday heroes. Whatever they're called, the COVID-19 pandemic has given Americans a new appreciation for the backbone of the workforce — the farmers, skilled laborers and tradespeople, delivery drivers, construction workers, mechanics and first responders who are keeping the country running during a crisis.

But even before a virus made us reappraise the value of an occupation, *The Amazing Race*'s Phil Keoghan was working on a TV show that would showcase the talents, toughness and intellect of blue-collar workers. Keoghan is host and executive producer of the 10-episode series *Tough as Nails*, which puts 12 essential workers to the test in real work challenges for a chance to win cash and the title of *Tough as Nails* champion.

"The show is to honor working-class people like my relatives," Keoghan says, noting how the time he spent with his mechanically adroit granddad demonstrated to him the wondrous work that can be accomplished with human hands and ingenuity. "I take pride in the fact that I come from working-class people, and quite frankly, if it wasn't for those people doing what they do, we wouldn't have a country that functions."

In the *Tough as Nails* format, the competitors take on real-world job challenges, such as lugging fire hoses in full firefighter gear and hammering spikes into railroad

ties. There are two competitions running simultaneously throughout the series: Contestants vie as individuals to be crowned the ultimate *Tough as Nails* champion, and they also compete in team challenges. "Even if somebody gets cut from the individual competition and they're out of contention for the overall prize, they do not go home," Keoghan says. "They stay and they continue to compete in a team competition."

And there are no losers. "These are people who live paycheck to paycheck who work extremely hard," Keoghan says. "The idea that we would ask them to take time off work to come and be part of the show, and that they would then be putting in all this effort and walk home empty-handed, just didn't sit right."

As for *The Amazing Race*, Season 32 was originally scheduled to premiere in May, but it will now debut this fall to fill a potential content void as production on other CBS shows is in limbo. Keoghan was shooting Season 33 when production was halted, and things were still too unpredictable for him to say when it might resume. While he wishes in hindsight that they could've started filming Season 33 earlier, he says, "The fact that we are in this very lucky situation of being able to cut together *Tough as Nails* is extremely fortuitous."

And *Tough as Nails* might be the right show at the right time for people in need of uplifting entertainment.

"Usually I go into people's homes and I organize, and I surprise them. This was really them taking ownership of their stuff, and they had the guidelines for their organizing style, but they were transforming their home all by themselves," Cas concludes. "It's inspiring, and it's incredible what these families were able to accomplish."

"Your physical environment has such a negative impact on your self-esteem, your self-worth and your happiness. Seeing people overcome this burden, this mountain of their clutter, it's all of these unkept promises that they've made to themselves, and in days you can really see this life-changing transformation in their space, but in themselves, too."

"It's the biggest, wettest, wildest water sports competition ever!" Those words come straight from the mouth of the cohost of USA Network's *Cannonball*, Mike "The Miz" Mizanin, about the new 10-part series. Basically, if you're looking for daredevil stunts performed in water by regular people, *Cannonball* is just what you need this summer.

"You take NCAA athletes, you take average Joes, you put them in a water sports competition. Anyone can win. It's insanity," explains The Miz. "And it's so funny. It's laugh-out-loud comedy." He decided to sign on after hearing about the show from Day 1. "When they told me the premise, I said, 'There's only one person for this job.' And it's me," he said. "I get to just sit there and watch and guide you through the entire obstacle course."

The highlight of that obstacle course is the "mega slide," a massive water slide that launches its passengers into the air. The goal is to launch the farthest – but that takes more skill than you might think. "First, you have to have a good entry to get a jump into the slide, and it's got to be smooth. [But] when you're going down, fear sets in. Not in the first part, but in the second part of the slide, because you start really getting a lot of speed. You'll notice people start putting their feet down, and we call it a 'drag city.' And basically, if you drag, you become slower, and that will hinder your launch."

The 10-part series is equally hilarious, jaw-dropping and provocative. The guests come with all sorts of baggage, but share a universal goal to better their lives, whatever that may take — even if it's, well, unimaginable.

"We felt like this was a story that hasn't been told in terms of retreats that exist and what actually happens," tells Jessica Sebastian-Dayeh, executive producer and president of ITV America's Sirens Media, the production company behind the series. "It's a genuine, legitimate healing retreat."

As for what actually happens, that's where the real entertainment begins. For the eclectic guests, their three-week

retreat is a completely immersive experience of modalities and treatments that range from rage ceremonies and spiritual exorcisms to shamanic cacao ceremonies and orgasmic healings. They scream, they vomit, they have tantrums and they hold a talking stick that gives them the power to voice themselves. "Who has the talking stick in her hands? Christine does!" Christine reminds her peers.

"It's a really entertaining show because this world is such a melting pot of personalities," Sebastian-Dayeh concludes. "It's soapy. There's high school drama. There's hookups. There's healing, but there is definitely a lot of comedy because these people are in a fish-out-of-water experience that really does lend itself to humor just naturally. When you throw together nine people into a world they haven't experienced before, with all types of crazy healing, there's so much great entertainment."

VALERIE BERTINELLI: IN MY OWN WORDS

From Fresh-Faced Teen Actor To Food Network Star, The Actress Shares It All. By Meredith Ennis

Actress Valerie Bertinelli invites the cameras into her feminine, plant-filled living room in REELZChannel's *Valerie Bertinelli: In My Own Words*. In an hourlong episode that feels like a chat with a new friend, Bertinelli talks about her personal life, television career and relatable struggles with body image and weight gain. Comments from Norman Lear, friend Faith Ford, *One Day at a Time* castmate Mackenzie Phillips, Bertinelli's brother David and others are peppered throughout Bertinelli's reflections on her life, along with photographs that reveal just how ageless the dark-eyed beauty appears to be.

Bertinelli got her first big acting break in 1975, when she was just 15 years old. She recalls that on her first day of filming *One Day at a Time*,

waiting to make her entrance, she was "holding on to the door and going 'this is going to change my life.' At 15. I knew it was going to change my life."

Bertinelli married guitar icon Eddie Van Halen after a whirlwind romance and, for awhile, the two lived the glamorous lifestyle of a rock star and famous actress, eventually having a son. Bertinelli describes the couple's struggles with infidelity and drug and alcohol use, tearing up at times and declaring, "I never ever want to hurt anybody like that again. I don't want to be hurt like that again." It's this raw honesty and real pain – that also surfaces when Bertinelli talks about her father fat-shaming her mother, and about her own issues with weight – that makes for compelling viewing.

Smiling and laughing, Bertinelli sums up her life so far saying, "That's my life story: 'She worked hard and she got lucky.'"

THE ALIENIST: ANGEL OF DARKNESS

Dakota

In early 2018, TNT debuted *The Alienist*, an often gruesome psychological murder mystery set in 1896 Manhattan, where the Gilded Age's economic expansion, industrial advances and scientific achievements hid a grimy underbelly of corruption, organized crime and social inequality.

In a dark corner of this world stalked a killer with a compulsion for ritualistically killing young boys. With the police force crippled by crookedness, it was up to psychologist (a.k.a. "alienist") Dr. Laszlo Kreizler (Daniel Brühl), newspaper illustrator John Moore (Luke Evans) and police secretary Sara Howard (Dakota Fanning) to crack the case.

The Alienist returns for a sequel season, called *Angel of Darkness*, based on the second book of Caleb Carr's Kreizler series. While not exactly light summer entertainment, viewers who couldn't take their eyes off the first season will definitely get hooked into the disturbing case of a Spanish diplomat's kidnapped infant daughter and the ritualistic murder of a baby snatched from its mother in a hospital.

The story picks up in 1897, as the case of a young woman wrongly sentenced to death brings Kreizler, John and Sara back together.

Sara has opened her own private detective agency, and while her biggest clients have been wealthy ladies who want to know if the servants are stealing silverware, she's about to take on the toughest challenge of her young career.

"We see Sara get kind of propelled into the next level of her life," Fanning says. "She has forced her way into a man's world even more so by opening her own detective agency. She's kind of riding through this period of still being the 'lady detective' and still coming up against barriers. But she's persevering, and even just being a lady detective is groundbreaking."

Sara provided a unique opportunity for Fanning, as well. "It was my first time getting to go back and play the same character again, and it was really exciting," she says. "I felt like I had gotten to know her so well while doing *The Alienist*, so I was very protective of her this time around."

Meanwhile, John is a reporter for *The New York Times* and engaged to vapid socialite Violet Hayward (Emily Barber), but his relationship with Sara remains complicated. "John and Sara definitely have some unfinished or unrequited feelings for each other, and that's definitely a part of this story," Fanning teases. "For Sara, so much of the time we see her being strong and we see her being tough and we see her breaking down barriers and pushing boundaries and fighting. In the scenes that Sara and John have together, you see her as just a young woman ... you see the softer side of Sara in those scenes. That was really lovely to get to play out. I can say that the journey's not over for them."

Factual Fiction

While a fictional story, *The Alienist* interwove actual historical events and famous figures of the period into its narrative – with a twist of embellishment. Then-police commissioner and future president Theodore Roosevelt (Brian Geraghty) was a major character throughout the first season.

"I've always loved that there have been real characters peppered through a fictional world," says star Dakota Fanning. "I definitely think it adds a layer of something extra to the story, and I do think people respond to that."

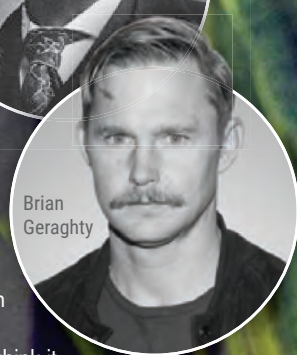
Angel of Darkness opens with the case of Martha Napp (Hebe Beardsall), a young mother convicted – despite an astounding lack of evidence – and sentenced to death at Sing Sing Correctional Facility for the killing of her infant daughter. Napp is to be the first woman put to death in the newfangled electric chair, which is believed to be "more humane" and less messy than the gallows. Roosevelt, who is now the assistant secretary of the Navy, is asked to intervene in halting the execution.

In truth, the first woman to be executed in the electric chair was 49-year-old Martha M. Place in 1899. Place was found guilty of murdering her 17-year-old stepdaughter. Despite an appeal to then-governor Roosevelt to commute the sentence, Place was put to death at Sing Sing.

Also in *Angel of Darkness*, we find William Randolph Hearst sensationalizing newspaper headlines, Elizabeth Cady Stanton fighting for social justice and Americans of Spanish descent enduring heightened acts of racism driven by political tensions between the U.S. and Spain.

NASCAR hits the Brickyard for a big holiday weekend

Brickyard Bonanza

IndyCar And NASCAR Do A Doubleheader At Indianapolis Motor Speedway.

Independence Day weekend 2020 might not be like the star-spangled celebrations we've enjoyed in the past, but at least there will be fireworks in the epicenter of the motorsports universe. Too bad fans won't be there to see it.

A historic weekend at Indianapolis Motor Speedway has IndyCar and NASCAR events in consecutive days at the hallowed racetrack. The grandstands will be nearly empty due to the COVID-19 crisis, but all races are televised by NBC.

On July 4, NTT IndyCar Series drivers Josef Newgarden, Alexander Rossi, Scott Dixon, Simon Pagenaud, Will Power and others race for 85 laps around the speedway's 14-turn, 2.439-mile road course in the GMR Grand Prix, which was rescheduled from May.

Following the IndyCar race, the NASCAR Xfinity Series

holds the Pennzoil 150 at the Brickyard, the first NASCAR race ever held on the track's road course. Noah Gragson, Chase Briscoe, Harrison Burton and Austin Cindric are among the series' top up-and-coming drivers.

On Sunday, the NASCAR Cup Series Big Machine Hand Sanitizer 400 at the Brickyard has Kevin Harvick, Joey Logano, Kyle Busch, Denny Hamlin, Chase Elliott and other stars driving for 160 laps around Indy's 2.5-mile oval. Harvick started last year's race at the pole and finished first, getting to plant a victory kiss on the Yard of Bricks.

Elsewhere in racing, Formula One will start its season with eight races in Europe. Austria hosts races July 5 and 12, and the Hungarian Grand Prix is July 19. F1 plans on having 15-18 races this season, with more to be announced. ESPN and ESPN2 will televise.

Playing Catch-Up

July could see the NBA and NHL return, but time is running out for Major League Baseball.

The NHL announced it will forgo the rest of its regular season and jump right into the Stanley Cup playoffs, which begin with 24 teams qualifying. Sixteen teams compete in a qualifying round, and the top four teams from each conference play in a round-robin tournament to determine playoff seeding. Games will be played in two hub cities – one for each conference – without spectators. Training camps open July 10, and a season restart date is to be announced. NBC, NBCSN and NHL Network will televise the games.

The NBA plans to resume its season with 22 teams competing at Disney's ESPN Wide World of Sports complex in Orlando, Fla. Qualifying teams would compete in regular-season and play-in games to establish playoff berths in both conferences. Camps open July 9, and the league is targeting a July 30 restart. ESPN, ABC, TNT and NBA TV will televise games.

In mid June, Major League Baseball's owners and players were still hotly negotiating a plan to take the field – player compensation and the number of regular-season games played being the main points of contention. With many logistics still to be determined, chances were slipping that baseball could salvage a shortened season starting in July. – RAB
