





haven't gotten to thank yet, and that's those who watched.

It is not lost on me how many shows there are out there, how many answers there are to the 'what are you watching' question at that stilted dinner party. It is not lost on me that people come home from long days at work, and long days with children, at a tricky time in the world – and get just a few hours to themselves. And if you've chosen to spend ANY of those hours with us – whether you stayed from start to finish, or lapsed somewhere in between – I just want to say thank you.

Watching 'This Is Us' is a contact sport. And in a way, I've always felt this show has been a bit of a hug between those making it, and those watching. Which sounds incredibly cheesy, and – logistically – would be awkward and impossible. But you know what I mean. I hope [the final episode] satisfies and leaves you thinking, and feeling, and even smiling. I hope it makes you feel as full as your response to this show has made us feel, all these years. And so, from the bottom of my heart, on behalf of all of US:

Thank you for taking this train ride with us. It's been the trip of a lifetime."

QUESTIONS WITH CATHERINE BELL

Catherine Bell is a familiar face to many with her long-running starring roles on shows like *JAG*, where she played Sarah MacKenzie for nine seasons, *Army Wives*, where she played Denise Sherwood for seven seasons, and *Good Witch*, where she played Cassie Nightingale for seven seasons and in seven movies.

Bell's latest project has her starring in the Lifetime original movie *Jailbreak Lovers* (airing Saturday, July 2) as Toby, a good woman but a lousy criminal. As the title of this based-on-a-true-story tale implies, she's involved in a jailbreak. Toby is a sweet wife and mom who's led a sheltered life and finds solace in dogs. She starts a program at a prison where inmates train abandoned dogs until they can be adopted. But when a convict lavishes attention on her, Toby falls for him.

Speaking from her sunny home in Florida, Bell answered our "5 Questions."

Tell us about a time when you were starstruck.

I was new on JAG, which was my first big show, and I was at a CBS event with a bunch of celebrities. And there's Tom Selleck. I grew up on Magnum, P.I. He came over, we were at a food table, and he started talking to me. Don Bellisario created JAG and Magnum, and I introduced myself like [Selleck] would never in a million years know who I am. And he was like, "Oh, I know who you are, girl." And he gave me a hug. I was like, "Oh my God, Tom Selleck knows who I am!"

If you were not an actor, what would you be doing?
I would probably be a fine artist. It's what I originally wanted to do, but my mom wanted me to get a more traditional education. So I went to UCLA and did that for a little while. I love to paint and draw. My daughter is graduating high school now, and she's going to a fine arts school.

What other jobs have you held?

I modeled for a couple of years. I didn't love it. It was just so much attention on your body and your weight and whether your face was too wide or not wide enough. Oh my gosh, I couldn't do it. I did not waitress for long. I was fired. Shortly after that, I became a massage therapist.

Have you ever had a ghostly experience?

Yes, it was subtle. I lived in Charleston, South Carolina, for seven years when we were filming *Army Wives*. And Charleston is considered the most haunted city in the U.S. I lived in a beautiful old home on The Battery, and this general built these three townhomes side by side. I had my office in the attic. I didn't always love to be up there because something just felt not right. I don't know what it was. It was beautiful, light and airy, and it should have been lovely. I had just made it my office and had my desk up there, and I don't know how to describe it, but I just didn't feel like I was alone. I packed up my stuff, and I left the attic, and I don't think I ever went back.

If you could have a dinner party with anyone, who's there?

Nelson Mandela, Desmond Tutu, and we could have the Dalai Lama.

THE TV SHOPPING CRAZE

How Home Shopping Channels Weathered The Pandemic And Made Us All More Savvy Shoppers. By Lori Acken

t's just before noon on a springtime Monday morning and Terri Conn, the Emmynominated former soap star turned QVC host, is wearing a bathing suit, even though she's on set and on the job.

Her vibrant blue Kim Gravel tankini and brief set is modest but not matronly and flatters the 47-year-old's figure, tanned skin and platinum hair. That the swimwear set, the network's signature Today's Special Value (on that spring day), rings in at just \$49 (five easy payments of \$10.50) and comes in sizes 2 to 34 is a potential godsend to the millions of women who regularly tune in to the 36-year-old shopping network and are very much aware that swimsuit season is not so far way. (FYI, they are

already sold out on sizes 2, 14 and 16.)

Not only does Conn don the swimwear, but the cameras also cut away to a pleasantly average-sized live model posing in it as well, giving athome shoppers a fine idea of how the number might look on them, too. But unlike days past, when host and seller chatted side-by-side, and a parade of models showed off the product in multiple colors and sizes, these are still pandemic times. Conn and her model companion are on different sets, and Gravel chimes in virtually. The effect is still reassuringly coffee-klatch cozy for longtime viewers and adheres to the QVC mantra of educating the consumer before they buy, but the safety-first setup is yet another example of the network's ability to adapt to an everchanging retail landscape, with those allimportant customers front of mind.

And these aren't fickle buyers who can be lured by bottom-barrel prices for compromised quality, fast-fashion trends and decor du jour. Though the network boasts a host of product lines - from electronics, automotive goods and home improvement supplies to grooming and jewelry offerings - designed to appeal to male buyers, the majority of shoppers with QVC are females between the ages of 35 and 64 who are affluent, educated homeowners, and boast, as the company's 2019 fact sheet proudly notes, a net worth 3.3 times the U.S. average. And they want to shop like it, with prestige brands, guaranteed quality and customer service.

Home shopping networks have

quietly stayed out of the media spotlight until recently when Showtime's hilarious *I Love That for You* (starring *SNL*'s Vanessa Bayer) gave a behind-thescenes look at their fascinating inner workings, which prompted us to take a deeper look into the history and success story behind these behemoths.

HSN - née Home Shopping Network - launched in 1981 and evolved from a series of local access shopping shows developed by radio station owner Lowell "Bud" Paxson, who discovered he could successfully sell items over the radio. QVC followed when Franklin Mint founder Joseph Segel polished Paxson's idea, gave cable providers a share of his profits as incentive and debuted the network in 1986, turning QVC into must-see TV. The two networks merged under the Qurate Retail Group umbrella in 2017, creating a multipronged global video commerce empire that reaches more than 200 million homes worldwide with 14 television networks, seven retail brands (including upscale lifestyle retailer Garnet Hill, home goods purveyor Grandin Road and online discount retailer Zulily) and a myriad of streaming services, social media pages, mobile apps and websites.

In the year before COVID struck, QVC already reached 8.3 million U.S. consumers and HSN reached 4.5 million. Both brands now get more than 50% of their revenue from online and app purchases, as even longtime viewers began to embrace the convenience of digital shopping (you can watch the live show on the QVC app and your computer).

When the pandemic dragged on, both networks and their digital offshoots were in prime position to cater to shoppers suddenly largely confined to their homes, with few brick-and-mortar options to choose from and fear of a deadly new virus keeping them away from even those. Offering a more curated, upscale home shopping experience than the black-hole Amazon universe, Qurate Retail Group's revenue



A QVC GEM RETURNS

Kathy Levine, one of the network's original and best-loved former hosts, returned to the network on June 1, two-plus decades after she moved on to other ventures. And, as is fitting for this multifaceted gem of the television retailing universe, Levine came back as a guest with her own line within QVC's iconic simulated diamond brand, Diamonique. Levine is best known for her rollicking jewelry shows with her friend and fellow entrepreneur, the late Joan Rivers.

And for I Love That for You viewers wondering if Levine had to toe the newbie line (something Vanessa Bayer's home shopping host Joanna has to do often on the Showtime series), even if she could once lay claim to millions in sales for the network, the answer is a hearty yes ma'am.

"I had to go back to what QVC calls Guest Class to qualify to come back," she says. "It's just protocol. Doesn't matter that you might have been the first host, or you were considered the best for a while. You are new. We don't know you. And you gotta sit in class with nine other new people who have products coming on."

grew 10% in the second quarter of 2020 alone. Combined traffic to QVC's and HSN's websites leaped by 36%. And while fashion sales took a hit as people found themselves with little to dress up for, interest in food and cooking products, electronics, home decor and outdoor living items skyrocketed.


Add to that some serious star power, too.

On the heels of the late Joan Rivers, whose jewelry and clothing lines lent new cachet to QVC when they debuted in 1990, today's customers can purchase home goods from popular HGTV personalities Drew and Jonathon Scott, lifestyle maven Martha Stewart and movie star Catherine Zeta-Jones; clothing and accessories from designers Isaac Mizrahi and Bob Mackie, and soapstar-turned-Real-Housewife Lisa Rinna; ready-made meals from Rinna's fellow Housewife Shannon Beador; footwear from pop star Katy Perry; and shades from Jamie Foxx's Prive Revaux line.

Over on HSN, shoppers can find globally inspired fashion and accessories from supermodel Iman; footwear and fashions from pop princess Jessica Simpson; luggage from TV traveler Samantha Brown; and cookware, cookbooks and edible items from celebrity chefs Wolfgang Puck, Emeril Lagasse and Curtis Stone.

And they're guided in the experience by a methodically trained and monitored cast of hosts, many of whom have been with their respective networks for 20 years or more.

All of this has paid off. Qurate Retail Group claims today that it's the largest player in video commerce, which includes video-driven shopping across its TV channels, e-commerce sites, digital streaming and social platforms. With nearly all consumers forming new shopping habits in a time of collective change and each network boasting decades of experience in responding to their needs, the future looks bright for these TV titans of retail.

This tragic story of lavish wealth, greed and the horrifying actions a grandmother, Olivia Foxworth, took to hide her daughter's children would play out in seven additional novels that became a pop culture phenomenon, later spawning numerous film adaptations.

Lifetime's four-part limited movie series Flowers in the Attic: The Origin shares the heart-wrenching, twisted story of Olivia Winfield Foxworth. The saga is led by Jemima Rooper along with a starstudded cast that includes Max Irons (Condor), Kelsey Grammer (Frasier), Harry Hamlin (Mad Men), Paul Wesley (The Vampire Diaries), Kate Mulgrew (Orange Is the New Black) and Hannah Dodd (Harlots).

Olivia is a contemporary woman who thrived working alongside her beloved father (Hamlin), until she is unexpectedly wooed by the wealthy Malcolm Foxworth (Irons). After their marriage, she finds herself as the mistress of the lavish Foxworth Hall, where her fairy tale love turns into a horrific nightmare.

Rooper, who grew up in England, definitely heard of the book series, but couldn't recall the details when she first read the project. "It was only when I started mentioning it to friends, and other parents at my son's school, that I realized there are a lot of people who were completely hooked on the books, and it was really part of their growing up, and they were so excited that I was even auditioning and that there was this show being made about the origin story," Rooper tells us. "From my point of view, I'm almost relieved that I didn't know quite the power of the V.C. Andrews catalog because I think I would have been probably a lot more daunted than I already was.'

Diving into her character was a journey, as her initial reaction to Olivia

was that she was an awful woman. Once receiving the full script she saw something different. "She's a strong young woman at the beginning of the story," Rooper tells. "And the intrigue of how does this person become that person - it's a dream come true for any actor [to play]. Her story is tragic as well."

While we start following Olivia as a young, vibrant woman, she eventually becomes the horrible grandmother to her famed grandchildren Cathy, Chris and twins Carrie and Cory.

"We can all be capable of things we never dreamed of, and there are quite a few points over the course of the four episodes where Olivia finds herself in certain situations and has to make a choice," she concludes. "And, it's not necessarily the choice that you would want to make, but at the time, it is the best of a bad bunch, it seems."


Ultimately, her character states it best in the beginning narration: "Some may have an idea of who I was - a wife, a mother, THE grandmother, a monster. I only ask that you withhold final judgment until you know the true story and knowing the truth, judge me if you dare." - Barb Oates


LOOK FOR!

Andrews' universe? And what did you think about it? To be entirely honest, I wasn't familiar with it. I had heard

of the book but had never read it. When I was offered the role, I did a bunch of digging and found out what a popular cult franchise this was. And Paul Sciarrotta and the team's interpretation and script really impressed me.

On a moral compass, how best would you rate your character in Flowers in the Attic: The Origin?

On a scale of 1 to 10, with 1 being immoral, he is a zero. A very confused and broken man who uses religion throughout his life as a means of dealing with his very severe issues. But we see towards the end of the limited series that the facade ends and his true self is revealed.

How would you describe your character's relationship with Olivia (Jemima Rooper) over time? How fun was it aging into this character?

He's in love with her his entire life but he completely hides that. He puts on the act of a caring and loving person in her life but deep down he is infatuated with her. The aging process was incredible because it was so wildly realistic. To be honest it was a bit uncomfortable to see but also really fun. The trick was to also make sure my posture matched my physical appearance.





RUNNING WILD WITH BEAR GRYLLS: THE CHALLENGE

I remember first sitting down with Bear Grylls in 2007, when the rising star told me the hardest things in life for him were big cities, interviews and drink parties where he doesn't know anyone. "Honestly, I find those scarier," Grylls told me. Hardly the answer you'd expect from a guy who summited Mount Everest, survived a free-fall parachuting accident that left his back broken in three places and drank the water he extracted from hand-squeezing elephant dung. Fast forward 15 years and umpteen more adventures, and Grylls is still most comfortable in the environment he knows best - teaching survival tips. In his latest reiteration of adventure and survival - Running Wild With Bear Grylls: The Challenge - he teaches his celebrity guests (Natalie Portman, Ashton Kutcher, Florence Pugh, Simu Liu, Anthony Anderson and Rob Riggle) essential skills that they'll have to master and prove in a high-stress situation. Here he answers a few of our questions.

When it comes to teaching your guests essential survival skills, can you walk us through an example of one of these skills and what that guest needed to do?

Bear Grylls: All of our guests come on Running Wild because they want to challenge themselves and experience some of the magic that the wild can give us. This season I really try to also teach them some essential survival skills and then have them put what they've learned to the test at the end of each episode. Whether it is knots or navigation, ultimately the journey will come

down to a point where it's all on them. That pressure can be tough when you're tired and a little afraid, but it's amazing to see them overcome and succeed.

What episode/adventure caused you the greatest amount of stress and why?

To be honest, every episode had its moments - that's the wild for you; it's highly unpredictable. We're out there taking risks, and for most of these celebrities, the journey pushes them beyond anything they've ever done. That's the thrill of the show for me: being beside these huge stars in some raw and high-intensity moments. With Simu Liu, we went to the Canadian Rockies and had to trigger an avalanche to clear a path - this can be extremely dangerous if not done properly. That journey was a wild ride for sure and ended up with us both in a frozen river in our underpants in zero degrees. A moment I won't forget! But Simu was amazing and 100% up for the challenge.

Who would you say had it the hardest and why?

It is always going to be challenging taking rookies into the wild when it's not something they're used to. Rob Riggle is also a former United States Marine officer, so I could push him in different ways to maybe someone less into the outdoors. But even Rob had a moment at the end of the journey that took him to the edge. We all have our edges. I try to adapt each journey for the ambition and skill of the guest; for example, Ashton Kutcher loved the jungle and the challenge and wanted to be pushed beyond what most people would enjoy. He did amazingly. Whether it's jumping out of planes, eating crickets, plunging into freezing waters or crossing alligator-infested swamps, this season feels like it has it all, and the guests were truly inspirational for me to lead. - Barb Oates

Four-week programming event beginning Sunday, July 10 on NAT GEO

National Geographic's annual shark-themed summertime programming event returns for its 10th installment, the biggest one ever, with nearly 30 hours of new programming and over 60 hours of enhanced content spanning four weeks across Nat Geo, Nat Geo Wild, Nat Geo Mundo, Disney XD, ABC and ESPN. Most specials will premiere on Nat Geo the week of July 10, with re-airs on Disney XD beginning July 16 through the end of the month. Titles will then re-air on Nat Geo Wild beginning the first week in August.

Things start July 10 on Nat Geo with Camo Sharks, which follows experts looking to understand how sharks may be able to manipulate their skin's dermal cells to activate camouflage that enhances their predatory abilities, followed by Backyard Bull Sharks, a look at how bull sharks may be expanding their range.

Other notable specials initially debuting on Nat Geo include *Maui Shark Mystery* (July 11), *Shark Queens* (July 13), *Baby Sharks* (July 13) and *Jaws vs. Boats* (July 17), among many others. There will also be a new, three-part series called *Planet Shark* (July 16), as well as new seasons of established series *When Sharks Attack* (July 11) and *Shark Attack Files* (July 18).

SHARK WEEK 2022

July 24-31 on DISCOVERY CHANNEL

Discovery's fan-favorite summertime event returns for its 34th installment, promising bigger sharks, bigger breaches, and even bigger findings from scientists and researchers in the field. Specific details about this year's new specials weren't available at presstime, but the programming will whisk viewers away to exotic, shark-filled locales such as the Exuma Islands in the Bahamas and Papua New Guinea. It will also spotlight innovative shark technology and research that are finding breakthrough information about these elusive creatures and their mating and migration patterns, in addition to the discovery of a new, undescribed species. Celebrities are often a part of Shark Week, and while all of the stars who may be appearing during this event weren't immediately announced, it was confirmed that the Impractical Jokers from the hit hiddencamera prank series on truTV (now one of Discovery's sister networks under the new Warner Bros. Discovery umbrella created by a recent merger) will embark on a hysterical adventure as they put their antics toward educating people about sharks.



Among the stunning revelations on display in this series: Plants are surprisingly social, and can communicate with each other, care for their young, and help the weak and injured; they can plan, count and remember; and some

plants can even hunt animals.

"We would starve without plants," says Attenborough. "We wouldn't be able to breathe without plants. Yet people's understanding about plants, except in a very kind of narrow way, has not kept up with that [awareness]. I think this series will bring it home."





GENERATION GAP Thursdays beginning July 7 on ABC **NEW SERIES!**

Jimmy Kimmel is an executive producer of this comedy guiz show that finally debuts nearly three years after it was ordered. The game show groups family members of different generations who must work together to answer questions about each other's generation. There will be pop-culture trivia and challenges such as asking an 8-year-old to finish the famous catchphrase "Go ahead. Make my BLANK." Kelly Ripa hosts and coproduces the series with her husband, Mark Consuelos. "It's time to bridge the Generation Gap with kids and grandparents going head-to-head against other pairs to see who knows each other's generation best," Ripa said.

THE FINAL STRAW Sundays beginning July 10 on ABC

Remember Kerplunk? That classic game with marbles dropping if you pulled out the wrong stick? This one reminds us of it. Offering a fresh and exciting format not seen elsewhere, this physical comedy competition series pits four teams of colorful contestants against tremendous tipping towers. Each life-sized themed tower is full of various objects, from basketballs to small kitchen appliances, as contestants try to successfully pull items from the stack without tipping it over. The last team standing will compete in the Mega Stack with a \$250,000 arand prize on the line. Comedian Janelle James hosts and Peyton Manning is an executive producer.





WHO DO YOU THINK YOU ARE?

This Emmy-winning celebrity genealogy docuseries from executive producers Lisa Kudrow and Dan Bucatinsky has a history that is almost as complex and fascinating as those of any of the guests it profiles. The series, based on a British format, originally debuted on NBC in 2010 and aired there for three seasons before being canceled in 2012. It was then picked up by TLC, where it aired for seven more seasons between 2013-18. In 2019, an announcement was made that Who Do You Think You Are? would be returning to its original NBC home for a 13-episode 11th season, and that's where we are at now.

AMERICA OUTDOORS WITH BARATUNDE THURSTON Tuesdays beginning July 5 on PBS

In this six-part travel and adventure series, bestselling author and outdoor enthusiast Baratunde Thurston explores a diverse array of wild spaces across the United States and discovers a vivid cast of characters of different backgrounds and abilities whose outdoor lives are shaped by the landscapes of where they live. The initial episodes premiering this month find Thurston in Death Valley, Idaho, Los Angeles and Appalachia.

"I think about [the title of] this show mentally as like America, comma, Outdoors," Thurston says. "It was a really joyful, intense and sometimes exhausting way for me to connect with my own country and its various peoples and so many different attitudes and politics – but on the terms of nature, not the terms of a political debate or even a spiritual experience.

According to executive producer Michael Rosenfeld, this series is "intended to really capture the way we as Americans experience the outdoors, which is a little bit like looking through a kaleidoscope because we experience it in so many different ways. ... We [did find] a lot of differences across the country, [but] we also found some themes that really sort of tie us together as a nation: love of the outdoors and a real desire to make the outdoors accessible."

"We've all a right to, and a relationship with, this land," Thurston adds. "This land is your land, this land is my land. We found so many beautiful examples [of this].

"Whether we go to the most extreme, remote and hot area, or we're just in our backyard doing urban gardening stuff, there is this opportunity to reground, re-center and connect with ourselves through our connection to the environment." – Jeff Pfeiffer





THE GREAT MUSLIM AMERICAN ROAD TRIP Tuesdays beginning July 5 on PBS **NEW SERIES!**

This three-part docuseries follows a young Muslim American couple - Syrian American rapper Mona Haydar and her husband, Sebastian Robins, who converted after meeting Mona - as they explore the famous Route 66 and its surrounding Muslim communities on a 2,500-mile drive from Chicago to Los Angeles.

The trip is an opportunity for them to not only experience the breathtaking panoramas and iconic roadside attractions along the route, but also to learn more about the history of their faith and what it means to be Muslim in America today. And some of what they found on their journey may surprise viewers, even as it sometimes surprised the couple.

"I think this is a story that shows, in some ways, interesting and unusual people in interesting and unusual places," Robins says, "but they are also living lives that are typical of 99.9% of Muslims worldwide. But somehow that is still unusual because that's not the story we are told." - JP

While her passion for the motorcycle industry is first and foremost (right now she only has three motorcycles inside of her actual house), home design and renovation is taking a close second for TV host and gearhead Cristy Lee. Filmed in her home state of Michigan, Lee's new show, HGTV's *Steal This House*, helps frustrated home buyers rethink the market and a home's potential (even homes covered in cedar from floor to ceiling that most would run from). Here she weighs in on how she looks at the market.

How are you getting homeowners to relook at home buying?

Cristy Lee: When homeowners go to purchase a home, they're generally looking at the top of their budget. They're not finding the square footage that they need, the type of style and decor that they need, but there's nothing left in their budget to make those changes. I'm trying to get them to look at a home in a completely different frame of mind.

So how does renovation come into play here?

By looking at houses in a very different price tier, they can lower the initial cost of the home in their budget and allow for more money to renovate. I'm guiding them through that process and helping them make some great choices for a home that they haven't been able to find and get the home of their dreams.

Do you try to leave something memorable from the original house in your renovations?

I do love when there's a part of the home that stays with the home. Sometimes that's a little bit easier if you have a '40s-era home with beautiful carpentry and woodwork everywhere. ... [Other times not so much.] It's a balance of finding a way to keep that character, keep the story history of that house intact. But sometimes you have to make it a little bit more stylish. So yeah, that's what I love about homes, and I love about real estate, is the story that they tell. – *Barb Oates*

STAR OF THE MONTH: DANA ANDREWS

Tuesdays beginning July 5 on TCM

Carver Dana Andrews - better known simply as Dana Andrews - is Turner Classic Movies' Star of the Month for July. Each Tuesday night (and extending well into the following day) is dedicated to the actor's films, with titles ranging from his leading-man heyday in dramas and films noir of the 1940s and early '50s to his later transition into more supporting roles. Among the many highlights are 1944's Laura (July 5), the film noir classic with Andrews as a detective obsessed with the titular presumed murder victim, played by Gene Tierney; 1946's The Best Years of Our Lives (July 12), the Best Picture Oscar-winning drama about World War II veterans struggling to readjust to life back home, featuring the star as a bombardier captain suffering from PTSD; and 1957's Curse of the Demon (July 19), an atmospheric horror film led by Andrews as a skeptical American psychologist targeted by a curse after running afoul of a satanic cult leader (Niall MacGinnis) in England.



THE CAPTAIN

Premieres Monday, July 18; airs Thursdays beginning July 21 on ESPN NEW SERIES!

Five-time World Series champion, Baseball Hall of Famer and N.Y. Yankees great Derek Jeter is the subject of the new seven-part ESPN Films documentary series The Captain, debuting after the network's coverage of the MLB Home Run Derby. Jeter, who spent his entire 20-year playing career with the Yankees and had his No. 2 jersey retired by the club in 2017, became an icon for his success on and off the field. He embodied class, charisma, commitment and character in an often-unforgiving baseball market that's always under the media's microscope. Jeter has carried those traits into retirement as he takes on new challenges as a team owner and executive, businessman, philanthropist, husband and father. "The series gives insight into a Hall of Fame baseball career, but more importantly, we reveal a person who sits at multiple intersections of American culture," says director Randy Wilkins. "The Captain is a story about race, media, celebrity culture and the insatiable drive to be the best version of vourself."





The town known for glitz and glamour welcomes a whole constellation of baseball stars, as Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles hosts the 92nd MLB All-Star Game festivities.

First up to bat is the fan-favorite T-Mobile Home Run Derby July 18 on ESPN. The All-Star Monday night tradition brings the big leagues' biggest sluggers to wow the crowd and send souvenirs to the seats. Pete Alonso of the N.Y. Mets has the chance to become the first player in derby history to win the event three straight times. A third win for Alonso would also tie him with Ken Griffey Jr. for the most all-time derby titles.

The following night on FOX, baseball's best as selected by fans, managers and players take to the field for the Midsummer Classic between the AL and the NL. The AL has an eight-game winning streak over the Senior Circuit, including a 5-2 victory last year at Denver's Coors Field. In order to

preserve pitchers' arms, there's a new rule in the event the score is tied after nine innings: The game shall be decided by a best-of-five-round Home Run Derby. FOX's new lead MLB play-by-play announcer Joe Davis calls the All-Star Game with analyst John Smoltz.

After the break, MLB gets back to the grind, with a lot to be decided before summer turns to fall. The new playoff format has a third wild-card team in each league and firstround byes for the two division winners with the best records, meaning teams with huge leads in the standings can't coast through the final two months. Top teams in pursuit of the AL playoffs are the N.Y. Yankees, Houston Astros, Minnesota Twins and Toronto Blue Jays. The L.A. Dodgers, N.Y. Mets, Milwaukee Brewers and San Diego Padres are among the NL's contending clubs.
