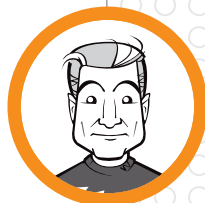

“LOVE ACTUALLY” Reunion Highlights Red Nose Day 2017

Most Of Cast From Hit Film Gets Together To Update Their Characters. By Jeff Pfeiffer

The Red Nose Day Special returns to NBC on May 25 for its annual U.S. airing, with a special addition to the broadcast: a *Love Actually* reunion film that will update fans of the 2003 romantic comedy on what many of the film's characters are up to in 2017.

Called *Red Nose Day Actually*, the short film is written

and co-directed by Richard Curtis, who helmed the feature film. Cast members revisiting their roles for this follow-up include Hugh Grant, Martine McCutcheon, Keira Knightley, Andrew Lincoln, Colin Firth, Lúcia Moniz, Liam Neeson, Thomas Brodie-Sangster, Olivia Olson, Bill Nighy, Marcus Brigstocke and Rowan Atkinson. Original costar Alan Rickman unfortunately passed away last year, and Emma Thompson will not be returning.

Entertainment Weekly also recently reported that Laura Linney will be back to reprise her role of Sarah in the U.S. version of *Red Nose Day Actually* (the Linney-less version of the film already aired in the U.K. as part of the Red Nose Day event there back in March).

This is NBC's third U.S. airing of the charity event created by Curtis that has been popular in the U.K. since its founding in 1988 as part of the nonprofit Comic Relief organization. It's part of a campaign to end child poverty worldwide, and features humor, music and vignettes like *Red Nose Day Actually* to help raise funds.

"Over the years I've enjoyed doing Red Nose Day specials of TV things I've worked on," said Curtis, "[like] *Blackadder* ... and *Mr. Bean*. It seemed like a fun idea this year to do a special sketch based on one of my films.

... I would never have dreamt of writing a sequel to *Love Actually*, but I thought it might be fun to do 10 minutes to see what everyone is now up to. Who has aged best? I guess that's the big question ... or is it so obviously Liam?"

At presstime, other participating talent for the U.S. version of *Red Nose Day* had not been announced.

5 Questions

With ... Ricky Whittle Of "American Gods."

Last month we introduced you to Starz's visually spellbinding adaptation of Neil Gaiman's best-selling fantasy novel *American Gods* (airing Sundays beginning April 30), and we think this cinematic new series could be TV's next great saga. Ricky Whittle, who viewers may recognize from The CW's *The 100* and ABC's *Mistresses*, stars as Shadow Moon, an ex-con whose physical strength and intimidating size belie a tender soul of great intelligence. When Whittle answered our "5 Questions," we learned that the actor is just as surprising as his character.



■ If your TV had only three shows or networks on it, what would you be watching?

Starz; I'd be watching *New Girl* [on FOX], which I think is the funniest thing I've ever seen; and at the moment I'm watching *SIX* on History, 'cause I've got two friends on that show – Kyle Schmid and Barry Sloane.

■ What three foods do you have to have in your fridge or pantry?

I would be eating pizza, steak and hot fudge brownie ice cream. I tell kids at home to "do as I say, not as I do," which is – I preach fitness and I look fit but, oh my goodness, my diet is terrible!

■ What do you think you'd be doing for a living if you weren't an actor?

I actually have a law degree, so I was going to go into law. ... I'm kind of like Shadow: I look like a big dumb jock, but there are brain cells in there.

■ What has been one of your strangest fan encounters?

Well, I just got sent underwear in my fan mail. And I just don't understand what the person sending them thought – [like] I'd open up this used underwear and think, "That's the girl I want to take home to show my mum." You know?

■ Tell us about a time when you were completely starstruck.

Pretty much every time I walk on set. And that's not even a joke. To *not* call Gillian Anderson "Scully" took all my strength. To *not* call Crispin Glover "McFly" took all my strength. To *not* call Ian McShane "Lovejoy."

We're dedicating some of this issue's column to frequently asked questions.

How do you connect a soundbar to the Hopper? – Karl

Hi, Karl. First, make sure your soundbar is Bluetooth enabled. Then, make sure your Bluetooth soundbar is in a discoverable mode. Next, go to your Hopper and get to the Main Menu. Select the SETTINGS tile, scroll to BLUETOOTH AUDIO, and turn BLUETOOTH PAIRING on. Then, select FIND DEVICES. Once the Hopper finds your soundbar, it will appear onscreen. You're all set! If you ever disconnect (say you turn your speaker off), simply come back to this screen and select CONNECT.

What are the benefits of pairing Hopper to a bluetooth device?

Many Bluetooth audio devices can be connected to the Hopper. Primary uses for Bluetooth are for streaming audio via headphones, headsets and speakers. You can create surround sound with a paired speaker, or listen to the TV without disturbing anyone else (like someone sleeping in the other room) by using headphones.

What is Primetime Anytime?

Primetime Anytime is free, and exclusive to DISH. It's part of DISH's Hopper

and Joey Whole Home DVR system. Once enabled, PrimeTime Anytime automatically records the programs airing during primetime on ABC, CBS, FOX and NBC. These recorded programs will be in your DVR for up to eight days, or you can save them for longer! Never miss your favorite movies, shows or sporting events again! And the best part of PrimeTime Anytime? AutoHop – a commercial-free way to watch TV. With AutoHop, you can skip through commercials within the PrimeTime Anytime programs. Primetime Anytime is free.

Can I keep my recordings from my old DVR if I upgrade to a Hopper?

Yes. You can connect an external hard drive to your existing DVR, then take that hard drive and plug it into your new Hopper! This allows you to keep your recordings and view them on your new receivers.

TV's Top Treasure Hunts

Has The Hunt For Treasure Yielded Only Riches In Ratings And No Bounty?

From pirate gold to royal jewels, the search for missing treasures has fueled many to risk life and livelihood in hopes of grand riches and notoriety. TV has also struck it rich in ratings gold with many popular treasure-seeking shows. Here we showcase a handful of them and rate their treasure-seeking success.



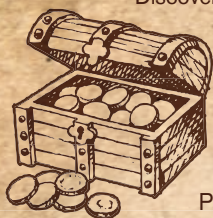
Gold Rush

Discovery Channel's No. 1-rated show follows three diverse miners and their respective teams in their attempts to find gold in Alaska, the Yukon and other parts of the world. For seven seasons, we've followed the gambler Todd Hoffman, 22-year-old Parker Schnabel and hothead Tony Beets as they prospect, move dirt and sluice for big-time nuggets. Schnabel has regularly walked away with millions, but this past season he hit major pay dirt when he simultaneously worked two wash plants on his claim, which yielded him his biggest gold weigh of his life, worth over \$5 million. The show has been renewed for an eighth season and will return in fall.

Found Or Lost Forever? This one is a jackpot! These guys have found millions in gold.

Devil's Canyon

Based on the success of *Gold Rush*, Discovery's next new series will explore the Devil's Canyon area of British Columbia, which is home to the largest creek-side gold deposit the world has ever seen. This area, however, is the most hostile terrain for survival. Three extreme prospectors head deep into the forest where big mining companies can't reach to find as much gold as they can before winter hits.

Found Or Lost Forever? We're betting this one will strike it rich.

Treasure Quest: Snake Island

A handful of adrenaline-fueled adventure seekers were scouring one of the world's deadliest islands (apparently over 4,000 snakes inhabit this 110-acre nightmare) in search of the legendary Treasure of the Trinity – an elusive Inca treasure of gold believed to be worth nearly \$400 million. Well, they didn't find the treasure there, but they did find a map (with a clue!), which took them deep into South America's Atlantic Forest in Argentina and to Season 2, where they found more maps (Jesuit treasure maps), an Incan nose plate and more that led to a cave that led to more drawings that led to a significant find. At the end of last season, the treasure hunters requested that authorities extend their location permit for another three months, and they continued to find "extremely valuable items linked to the Treasure of the Trinity."

Found Or Lost Forever? They found some extremely rare artifacts including an Incan gold sun mask. Discovery renewed the series for Season 3 to continue to chronicle what the team has uncovered.



The Curse of Oak Island

Ever since they were kids, Rick and Marty Lagina have shared an insatiable desire (Rick a little more than Marty) to solve the mystery surrounding Oak Island, a 140-acre island off the coast of Nova Scotia believed to be

the resting place of ancient treasures dating back to the Knights Templar (some even believe the ark of the covenant is located there). Many legends about deadly curses and glorious treasures surround the island that the brothers now co-own. They've spent years (four TV seasons) digging and searching for evidence of the treasure. "The goal is to solve the mystery. It's not so much of a treasure – my brother might differ a bit on that – but there is a wonderful story written there," Rick told us. "I'd like to put pen to paper and tell that story. We asked our father prior to his passing: 'Dad, if there's real treasure on Oak Island, what should we do with it?' My father didn't hesitate.

He said, 'Do good with it.' I guess that would be the endgame, if treasure were involved, and I believe that there will be." As of today, History has yet to renew the series for a fifth season. You can watch past episodes on On Demand.

Found Or Lost Forever? While we love the Lagina brothers, we think they've taken this exploration as far as it can go. The ark of the covenant is not on Oak Island.



Cooper's Treasure

This series, billed as "The Hunt for an Astronaut's Secret Fortune," launched April 18 and airs Tuesdays on Discovery Channel. While orbiting Earth looking for nuclear missile sites in the 1960s, pioneering astronaut Gordon Cooper believed he discovered a large number of shipwrecks in the Caribbean that could hold unimaginable wealth. Cooper worked for decades in secret to create a treasure map with the information he collected. Before his death in 2004, Cooper shared his secret with longtime friend and treasure hunter Darrell Miklos. The series follows Miklos and his team as they use Cooper's maps and data to hunt for sunken riches. "We've been lucky that the information that Gordon's given me is legitimate," Miklos says. "Luckily enough, the archival data that Gordon turned over to me has proven to be extremely accurate. And so far, we're five for five."

Found Or Lost Forever? Looks promising, though Miklos' ornery, foulmouthed father might be this show's most entertaining discovery.

THE WIZARD OF LIES

ROBERT DE NIRO AND BARRY LEVINSON REVEAL
THE HUMAN TOLL OF THE MADOFF SCANDAL.

In a pivotal scene in HBO's *The Wizard of Lies*, disgraced financier Bernie Madoff (Robert De Niro) and his devoted wife Ruth (Michelle Pfeiffer) don their pajamas and climb into bed – just as the couple did most every night of their 49-year marriage. A Judy Garland film flickers on the television and a bowl rests on the nightstand. It doesn't contain a late-night snack. It holds every pill the pair could scrounge up in their opulent Manhattan apartment. "Our last night on earth will be you, me and Judy Garland. How romantic," Pfeiffer drones in Ruth's distinctive Queens accent, which decades of privilege failed to polish into something more posh.

"We had a good life, didn't we?" Bernie says fondly, as his wife snuggles in. "Yeah," Ruth retorts. "Until you ruined it."

You already know that both Madoffs survived the overdose – a bid to escape the fallout of what would soon be revealed as the largest Ponzi scheme in history, one that bilked investors of \$65 billion, earned Bernie 150 years in prison, and imploded his family. But *Lies* isn't about dredging up a near-decade-old financial scandal. Based on *New York Times* reporter Diana B. Henriques' 2011 bestseller *The Wizard of Lies: Bernie Madoff and the Death of Trust* and directed by Barry Levinson, the film is, instead, a devastating character study centered on the fickleness and frailty of the human psyche. Was it faith, ego or psychopathy that led a trusted financier to perpetuate a decades-long fraud for which he had no exit plan? What drove others to ignore Madoff's improbable returns in a volatile market and trust him with millions? And how much did Madoff's own family members truly know of the scam?

Henriques – who plays herself and serves as narrator – had unprecedented access to the imprisoned Bernie. Re-creations of their interviews frame the film – and allow De Niro to deliver a quiet storm of a performance as the fallout of Bernie's sins becomes ever more apparent, despite his attempts to tell himself otherwise. "He came off candid, relaxed, sincere and trustworthy," Henriques observes. "That is his talent and his curse." De Niro agrees. "We felt that he's somebody who doesn't have to make a huge effort to get people to invest," the acting legend says. "They're lucky they can even get his attention. It's a classic element of a certain type of con – it's a privilege to get his recognition. That's a very powerful position, and he got into that position, probably through his demeanor. He looked like a guy you could trust – Uncle Bernie."

Papa Bernie is another story. Secretive and unsentimental with sons Andrew (Nathan Darrow) and Mark (Alessandro Nivola, a veritable study in devastation), he set the men up for financial success via his investment firm's legitimate brokerage arm, while keeping them and their mother in the dark about the fraudulent wealth management arm until it was too late to save them from the scorn and implication that would turn Ruth into a recluse and drive the tormented Mark to suicide.

Instead Madoff employed everyday folks on the firm's now infamous 17th floor – the kind of blue-collar souls who could

believe that earning millions despite no financial education is their due. Though Madoff's right-hand man Frank DiPascali (Hank Azaria) admitted he soon knew their dealings were shady, his boss universally caused people to *believe*. In a jawdropping scene, Madoff welcomes suspicious federal regulators into his firm for a sixth time, with no lawyers present, and calmly offers his International Securities ID Number, knowing it would finally expose the fraud or augment his belief that the whole American financial system is, as he claims, "rigged."

"It's a great moment," De Niro says. "Just leap off a cliff and hope for the best. It's almost nihilistic. And they bought it."

De Niro did not meet Madoff, but Pfeiffer spent time with the real Ruth, and Levinson says her understanding of her character, coupled with her and De Niro's intense connection, made his job easy. "They would be talking, and somebody would go, 'This is Bernie and Ruth,'" he smiles. "It's one of those times where, as a director, I can just sit back and let it go."

"I love Michelle," De Niro nods. "This is the second time we've worked together. We did *The Family*, and that was a lot

of fun, so I was very, very happy that she was playing Ruth.”

The film's most shattering guessing game is, indeed, deciphering whether the fragile Ruth and her sons knew that all was not right with the family business. "This is an important part of the piece," Levinson says. "You grow up with everybody telling you your father is this wonderful man – even though he may be verbally abusive, even if he controls what Andrew eats. That's what you know. So when this thing blew up, emotionally your world is upside down. The man was your father, admired and loved – and he is a complete fraud."

"What could he do except protect them as best that he knew and rationalize it that they would not be held accountable?" De Niro reflects. "They were held accountable in another way, by public opinion. That was an unbelievable nightmare for those kids." And an avoidable nightmare had Bernie not spent years dancing around a devastating truth – which makes a scene of a beachside celebration, in which Madoff lets down his guard and gathers his family to dance to Neil Diamond's "Sweet Caroline," all the more poignant.

"They did have moments where things were joyous, so I wanted to show that dynamic," Levinson recalls. "As I remember it, we just said, 'We'll put the camera here,' and then Bob started to dance with Michelle. I pretty much just allowed their behavior to take over the scene. It was that simple. Just *dance*."

The final episode culminated with nightmare-inducing imagery, countless cliffhangers and a ghostly apparition of Laura Palmer, who eerily promised, “I’ll see you again in 25 years.”

WHO’S NEW?

The supersized cast has added a few new faces, including Jim Belushi, Amy Shiels, Robert Knepper and Chrysta Bell. Also making appearances are Trent Reznor, Laura Dern, Michael Cera, Amanda Seyfried and Naomi Watts.

When David Lynch and Mark Frost’s *Twin Peaks* debuted on ABC Sunday, April 8, 1990, it was unlike anything people had seen on TV before – certainly on broadcast television.

It brought the surreal sensibilities of Lynch’s film works to the small screen, and to an audience that may not have been familiar with weird Lynchian opuses like *Eraserhead* or *Blue Velvet*. Ostensibly, the show was about the investigation into the murder of young Laura Palmer in the small Washington town of Twin Peaks, but ultimately, Lynch seemed to be going after atmosphere, not necessarily story.

And he succeeded wildly on that front. The eerie visuals, Angelo Badalamenti’s moody musical score and the collection of offbeat characters helped *Twin Peaks* gain a cult audience almost immediately – a following the creators hope to rekindle and grow some 25 years later with their new story.

Kyle MacLachlan, who reprises his iconic role as FBI Special Agent Dale Cooper, has long thought about how exciting it would be to revisit the series.

“That, coupled with the chance to work with David Lynch again on something that I just really loved. So for it to actually come to pass, to actually come back around again, was completely unexpected. ... I was thrilled, thrilled,” MacLachlan says about what he considers to be “its own unique thing, for sure” and not necessarily a third season of the original show.

MacLachlan also credits the passionate *Peaks* fans for keeping the idea of a series return possible. When it comes to whether the patient original fans will be rewarded with any notable call-outs to the original show, MacLachlan is tight-lipped. “They’ve sworn me to absolute secrecy,” he laughs. “I wish I could tell you more.

“There’s definitely things for the fans, for sure,” MacLachlan teases. “But as you can imagine, the story, being 25 years later, is going to be different.”

And how different was it for MacLachlan coming to the set after 25 years, in the clothes and mindset of Dale Cooper?

“It actually started that first day,” he recalls, “seeing some of the characters and people that I hadn’t seen in a long time, in our trailers before we actually walked on set. That was really a reunion, as you can imagine. Really nice to see people I hadn’t seen forever and catch up, and to also see everyone back in their *Twin Peaks* look and style. It was pretty mind-blowing. I remember seeing David Lynch, and just how he had a big grin on his face. I’m sure I had a big grin on my face, and we just were really happy to be back working together.”

Showtime is billing *Twin Peaks* as a limited series. We asked MacLachlan if things had been left open for another season, if everyone wanted to.

“Hard to say,” he tells us. “I think that *Twin Peaks* has always got more stories there. I think it’s certainly possible. I don’t know what’s in the mind of David and Mark, but let’s just say if there were any interest from them, I would certainly be interested.”

DIRTY DANCING

Colt Prattes Is Johnny Castle For A New Generation. By Lori Acken

For Colt Prattes, playing bad boy dance instructor Johnny Castle in ABC's musical reimagining of the beloved 1987 film *Dirty Dancing* isn't just a dream come true but a coming full circle.

As a kid growing up in rural Georgia, Prattes watched the film with his stepmom whenever it appeared on TV and admired Patrick Swayze's cool, but didn't yet realize the impact the actor and role would have on his life. "Eventually she told me that Patrick's mom owned a dance studio and he'd been dancing his whole life. All of a sudden this world opened up to me," Prattes recalls. "I realized that it wasn't just something he did for the movie. This was something he did for a *passion*. You don't think of men as dancers, especially not in north Georgia, so it was something I was fighting against. Then, when I found out Patrick Swayze had been a dancer, I was like, 'Oh, it's *on*.' Because he's Patrick Swayze. He's *Road House*. He's *Point Break*. He's *Ghost*."

"It was a huge part of accepting being a dancer," Prattes continues. "My parents were both police officers and they were incredibly supportive of me, but I remember that my dad and my brothers would joke when I first started. I started singing first, and they were like, 'Just as long as you don't start dancing, buddy.' Then I started dancing. They were like, 'Just as long as you ain't doing ballet.' Then I started doing that, and they were like, 'It's cool, dude. Just do whatever you want.' There were no more jokes."

Especially when Prattes began making his living as a dancer in music videos and concerts and scoring ensemble gigs on Broadway. Still, he longed to break into television and films. Then his agent called about an acting gig that would also require he sing and dance – a TV remake of *Dirty Dancing*. His dream role. And when a callback landed him in front of another hero, the film's choreographer Andy Blankenbuehler, who recently worked on the Broadway smash *Hamilton*, Prattes wondered if it was all meant to be.

"I assumed, 'OK, there's going to be a bunch of us in the room' like any audition," Prattes recalls. "Instead I walked into an empty studio with myself

and Andy. We had both gotten there early, and we just sat and talked. If nothing else had happened, I would have still been over the moon about everything.”

Prattes landed the role and was soon performing alongside castmates Abigail Breslin, who plays Baby; Bruce Greenwood and Debra Messing as Baby’s parents; Nicole Scherzinger as Johnny’s bestie Penny; and Katey Sagal as his married lover Vivian Pressman. But don’t expect a carbon copy of the ’87 classic. This *Dirty Dancing* blends its coming-of-age story with a coming-of-middle-age story for the Houseman parents and boasts a distinctly girl-power feel. “We all knew the original and loved it and there was just that palpable energy of how important this story is,” Prattes explains. “In our version, you get to find out so much more about who these people are and more important, *why* they are. We get to expand those stories.”

Still, Prattes says, stepping into *Dancing*’s most iconic scenes – teaching Baby the lift and reminding her father that no one puts her in a corner – brought goose bumps. “The first thing I looked for when I got the script was, ‘Line ... OK, the line’s in there. The lift is in there.’ And when we did it, after they said cut, Bruce and Debra both stood up and cheered. Everybody, even the extras, clapped and cheered. It was a huge moment.”

And for some of those extras, a second chapter. “Some of the extras in our film were extras in the original, because it was filmed in the same area,” Prattes reveals. “They were old enough now to have children that were there, too. That was my favorite, to talk to them and hear stories about Patrick and Jennifer [Grey] and everybody on set. It made you feel really close to it.”

Nonetheless, Prattes says he paid homage to Swazye by *not* playing an exact replica of his Johnny Castle. “I wanted to approach it the same way that I felt that he did, which is just bringing as much of myself and my heart and my honesty and my story to it as I could. Because this story is a love story. It’s a thousand love stories. I’m so happy that new generations get to see this, and I hope people who’ve seen the original will appreciate the way that we did it and allow it to be fresh and new. This story, it’s *all* of our stories.”

WORLD OF DANCE

Prepare To Be Moved By The Planet’s Best Dancers. By Lori Acken

In promos for her new NBC dance competition *World of Dance*, executive producer and judge Jennifer Lopez calls the million-dollar contest “the Olympics of dance” and “the biggest dance competition in the world.”

But, says the show’s host and mentor Jenna Dewan Tatum, *WOD* isn’t just about who has the flashiest moves – it’s about how moved people are while watching each performance. “I believe it’s important to remind the world how incredibly important and healing the arts are,” Tatum says. “It lifts you up. We all need a bit of lightness in our life at the moment, and dance is incredible because it does bring people together. You don’t have to be a dancer yourself to feel moved by these performances.”

Culling its contestants (there is no age limit) and judging criteria from the international, traveling urban dance competition also called *World of Dance*, the show will feature performances from across all genres – from hip-hop and break dancing to ballet and ballroom. The competition consists of five rounds. In the first four rounds, dancers compete within their division, with the winner from each division dancing it out for the million bucks in the Grand Final.

Tatum proudly notes that she and each of the judges – *Dancing With the Stars*’ Derek Hough and actor/dancer/singer Ne-Yo round out the panel – were once struggling performers themselves and know the importance of hard work and a lucky break. “It was so important to be a part of a show for dancers by dancers,” says the former Janet Jackson backup dancer who met her husband, the hunky actor Channing Tatum, on the set of the 2006 dance film *Step Up* and will produce another NBC dance series with him. “Dance will always be my first true love, my roots, who I am. To be a part of a show that is celebrating and elevating dance is a dream come true. I am so excited to give dancers this incredible platform and opportunity – and the chance to be paid what they deserve.”

MICHAEL JACKSON: SEARCHING FOR NEVERLAND

Top MJ Impersonator Navi Plays The Pop Superstar In Lifetime Biopic.

Navi remembers the very moment he knew Michael Jackson would change his life. It was 1983 and the grade-schooler’s parents let their music-loving boy stay up to watch Don Mischer and Suzanne de Passe’s Emmy-winning documentary *Motown 25: Yesterday, Today, Forever* — the first time Jackson displayed his signature moonwalk dance move, during a thrilling performance of “Billie Jean.” “I taped the performance and ran upstairs, woke up my parents and played it for them,” the mononymous Londoner recalls. “I played it maybe 20 or 30 times that night. I couldn’t believe this performance ... and this man.”

As a teen, Navi began portraying his idol in appearances and tribute shows that have since taken him to 61 countries

and earned him work as a decoy and performer for the King of Pop himself. Now the self-professed “ultra fan” steps into Jackson’s skin in a way he never imagined, playing the icon in Lifetime’s biopic *Michael Jackson: Searching for Neverland*.

But he didn’t exactly leap at the role.

The Trinidad native admits his own protective instincts toward Jackson and his fans left him wary of the project, which is based on the best-selling

memoir *Remember the Time: Protecting Michael Jackson in His Final Days* from Jackson’s personal security team. The film presents an insider’s look at the tumultuous final years of Jackson’s life, as the pressures of famous fatherhood, an opportunistic inner circle, a rabid tabloid media and the fallout of his own increasingly erratic behavior spiraled the singer toward tragedy.

“I’ve turned down many opportunities over the years, even when Michael was around,” Navi explains.

Executive producer de Passe — an entertainment multi-hyphenate who helped launch the Jackson 5 while working at

Motown Records and also coproduced the Emmy-nominated miniseries *The Jacksons: An American Dream* – helped seal the deal. “To work in this film with her was something in itself,” Navi says. “And then to sit with her and get to know her and realize that she loved Michael, that she brought Michael to Motown, it was special that she was involved. Because this project, to me, is not about an achievement in my career, but the first time I’m able to do something *back* for Michael. I felt that I had a voice when he’s been silenced, and that maybe the voice that I have is the voice he wanted to be heard.”

Navi says he’s grateful the filmmakers took a chance on him, because he hopes his participation reassures Jackson super-fans that the film isn’t yet another cheap shot at a doomed genius. “What was presented to them was not an impersonator, but a person who worked with Jackson, who’s been around him, who knows how to portray him onstage – but also, somebody who could bring the character and the spirit of him to the film,” Navi says. “During a couple of points [portrayed] in the film, I was there personally. I remember the moment when we turned back to America from the Middle East. I remember when he announced the ‘This Is It’ concerts. And I remember when he passed away, when I heard it.”

Navi hopes audiences are as touched as he is by the revelation of Jackson as a devoted and fun-loving dad. “I could imagine what Michael went through as a father wanting to protect these children from the limelight, from the pitfalls of fame, and wanting to find them a home,” he says, adding that he was sometimes moved to tears on set. “What I took away most was how sorry I felt for him. As a fan, I looked at him in terms of what he could deliver in music, in videos, in performance and in appearances. I never looked at what it *cost* him. You’re seeing the lights and the dancers and the band and people enjoying the magic – but you don’t see the cost of what it entails. When I walked away from this film, I realized how I actually love Michael more as a person than as an entertainer.”

Twenty Years After Her Death, We Get Answers To The Questions Surrounding The Crash. By Barb Oates

Anyone over 40 most likely can still tell you exactly what they were doing on Aug. 31, 1997, when news broke of Princess Diana’s horrific car accident and death. While you may have never been to Paris, the Pont de l’Alma tunnel is etched in your memory, along with many lingering questions and sadness. Iconic people have that impact.

“I think that there are people in history that touch the world in different ways, and Diana was a fairy tale that everybody wanted to believe in. And while the fairy tale didn’t walk down the normal route of lovely endings, she evolved into this iconic figure,” tells Susan Zirinsky, senior executive producer of the special. “She was a selfless example of humanity. She really became a survivor story. ... We deal with the person, the tragedy of the moment, the tragedy of a life that wasn’t what it was expected [to be], but the survival aspect of a woman who really became empowered and made meaning of a life that could have been a very different story.”

CBS charts Diana’s legacy, as well as investigates the questions and conspiracies (and four independent investigations) surrounding her death in this two-hour special hosted by Gayle King. Over the past 20 years, numerous conspiracy theories and questions have swirled through tabloids. Was Diana killed intentionally? What was the involvement of the white Fiat Uno? The unknown dark car? What about the lone motorcyclist?

While Zirinsky wouldn’t elaborate on the specifics of what the special covers, she does think people will be satisfied with her team’s rich reporting. “We believe that from our historic reporting, and our current reporting, we will be able to say and put the cause of her death, and answer questions that have remained, and look at the conspiracies that still swirl around,” Zirinsky says. “I think we will answer some questions, and really come out with a satisfying end. And people then can take her legacy and move on.”

DOWNWARD DOG

Peek Inside The Mind Of Woman's Best Friend. By Kellie Freeze

Animal owners often wonder what goes on inside the minds of their pets, and ABC's *Downward Dog* – based on a successful web series of the same name – offers a glimpse inside Nan's (Allison Tolman) philosophical pooch, Martin. "I think it's a talking dog show that's *not* about a talking dog," says Tolman. "It's about humanity, and it's about humanity through the eyes of this dog who can look at us and see things that we can't see, and say things that we can't say about each other."

In the series, Martin observes the triumphs and tribulations of millennial Nan, and silently judges her decisions. But he is also a dog, who considers obedience class to be "couples therapy," and plots against a neighbor's diabolical cat while pondering his place in the world. "It's sweet and somber and sad and funny and bittersweet," shares Tolman.

After Tolman's Emmy- and Golden Globe-nominated run on *Fargo*, the actress searched for another convention-defying project. "I knew as soon as I saw the web series, as soon as I met with these guys, that this is where I wanted to be, and this

is where I wanted to spend my time, with this story and this group." The show's "group" includes Nan's sweet but slacker ex-boyfriend (*Raising Hope*'s Lucas Neff), her pigheaded boss (Barry Rothbart), her BFF/coworker (Kirby Howell-Baptiste) and her trusty pooch.

And Martin the dog – played by canine actor "Ned" and voiced by the series' co-creator, Samm Hodges – is the show's breakout star. He's TV's most charming dog since *Frasier*'s Eddie. Ned possesses a human-like gaze, an innate solemnity and acting prowess that costar Neff describes as "like a young 'Brandog.'" And while this series is about a talking animal, this isn't the broad humor of *Mr. Ed*. Martin doesn't speak to the humans in his life, nor does he chat with the other animals he encounters. He speaks directly to the camera in insightful confessionals. The show's charm comes from Martin's pathos – remarkably self-aware, and yet lovably clueless about life.

It was a controversial move the network explains as necessary to secure the best suitors for Lindsay. We chatted with host Chris Harrison about the gorgeous attorney and what viewers can expect in Season 13.

■ **This is the 13th season of *The Bachelorette*, and we've had 21 seasons of *The Bachelor*. Why has it taken so long to introduce a black bachelorette or bachelor?**

I think it's really for a number of reasons – probably longer than we could do on a phone call – but there was no real reason in particular. I think the good news is that we're doing it now and I'm really happy that Rachel, moreover, is just the right *woman* as opposed to the right *African-American* woman, or the right Asian or Latino, whatever. I'm just glad that we picked the right girl, and she was easily the best choice for the show.

■ **Why is Rachel the right choice to be the *Bachelorette*?**

Rachel, coming off last season with Nick, was incredibly popular with our crew, with the producers, with Nick, with the other girls, with the viewers. She struck a chord with everybody. She has the whole package, where she is obviously beautiful, but moreover, she is incredibly smart, very successful at what she does,

has so many attributes and so many great things going for her, but there is that thing that's been lacking, and there's a thing that's missing, and that's the key component for *The Bachelorette* is they have to be a little bit flawed.

■ **What will America learn about Rachel on *The Bachelorette* that we didn't get to see when she was on *The Bachelor*?**

You didn't get to see her wicked sense of humor, and you don't get to see just how strong she is and what an empowered woman she is. She is, for lack of a better term, a badass woman. You will really get to see that in full force.

■ **So what makes her appealing as the *Bachelorette*?**

Here's what I find very endearing about her, just spending time with her, is that there is this professional side. She's a lawyer. She's smart. There's all of that, which I think you know, but she has this charm and this charisma and this ability to really light up a room. When she walks into a room and smiles, she puts

everybody at ease. Honestly, night one when she walks in the room and just smiles, everyone just lights up.

■ **What's something that happens this season that fans have never seen before?**

[Laughs] I certainly can't let you know that because it's the most dramatic thing ever! It's historical and it's mind-blowing and all those other things I always say about anything that ever happens on the show.

■ **After so many seasons, what still surprises you?**

I guess just that it never gets old. And it never gets old for me, and it never gets old for the producers. I was at a rose ceremony last night and it was fantastic. We did have, in all seriousness, some drama happen and some things were pretty wild, and one of the producers and I looked at each other and I was like, "I love this show! I just love this show so much," because it never gets old. I think that's the reason it's stayed relevant for 15 years and it's been so good. Because if I'm sitting there after 35 seasons in 15 years, and I am giddy like a schoolgirl and excited about what's happening, you *have* to be as a viewer.
