■ “Home & Family” Update

What is the situation with Hallmark Channel's daytime talk show *Home & Family*? Is that ever coming back?

— Nadine

The Emmy-nominated lifestyle series officially came to an end in August after nine seasons. However, in today's TV landscape it's hard to say if it will ever come back, but for now it's not on the schedule.

■ “Ray Donovan” To Return?!

After that awful series finale of *Ray Donovan*, I hope what I heard is true and that they are bringing back the series. — Tommy

Kind of. The series isn't coming back, but Showtime is giving the show a proper ending with an original movie planned for 2022. “We heard from all the rabid ‘Ray’ fans, and we have responded. The movie will reunite Liev Schreiber, Jon Voight and the entire dysfunctional Donovan clan,” says Gary Levine, Showtime's president of entertainment.

■ “Yellowstone” Is Back!

I heard *Yellowstone* is finally returning, but do you need to have their streaming service now? — Carol

No, you don't need to have Paramount+ to watch the long-awaited return of “Yellowstone.” The fourth season will return to Paramount Network on Nov. 7. What you may be confused about are the origin stories of “Yellowstone,” which are titled “Mayor of Kingstown” and “1883.” These series will air on their streaming service, Paramount+, beginning Nov. 14 and Dec. 19, respectively. Paramount says: “Our strategy is to make ‘Yellowstone,’ the massive No. 1 hit with more than 10 million fans, into a global hit franchise under the incredible creative vision of Taylor Sheridan's world-



building storytelling. These new series will debut on Paramount+ and have special premiere-day sneak episodes behind ‘Yellowstone’ introducing this huge audience to these new stories, allowing us to leverage our linear platforms to fuel the growth of Paramount+, which will stream each series exclusively after Episode 2.”

■ What Ever Happened To?

I'm a new subscriber and I love your magazine. I noticed the letter section and I would like to know what happened to these shows: *Dating Naked* (VH1), *100 Code* (WGN), *Bring It!* (Lifetime), *Ex on the Beach* (MTV) and *UnREAL* (Lifetime)? — Horn

Let's start with “UnREAL.” The series was a hit for Lifetime and aired for three seasons before moving to streaming service Hulu for its fourth and final season in 2018. “Ex on the Beach” aired on MTV for four seasons with the most recent episode airing in February 2020, just at the start of the pandemic. The series is expected to return as casting calls and international filming have resumed. “Bring It!” delivered over 100 episodes and wrapped up in 2019. That might have been the final curtain call for the Dancing Dolls. VH1's “Dating Naked,” which ran for three seasons, will see a return after its 2017 cancellation, but it will be on the network's streaming platform

Paramount+. And the acclaimed Swedish crime drama “100 Code,” featuring detectives Conley (Dominic Monaghan) and Eklund (the late Michael Nyqvist) concluded in 2018. Given Nyqvist's passing, it seems unlikely that a new season (or a reboot) will be made in Sweden.

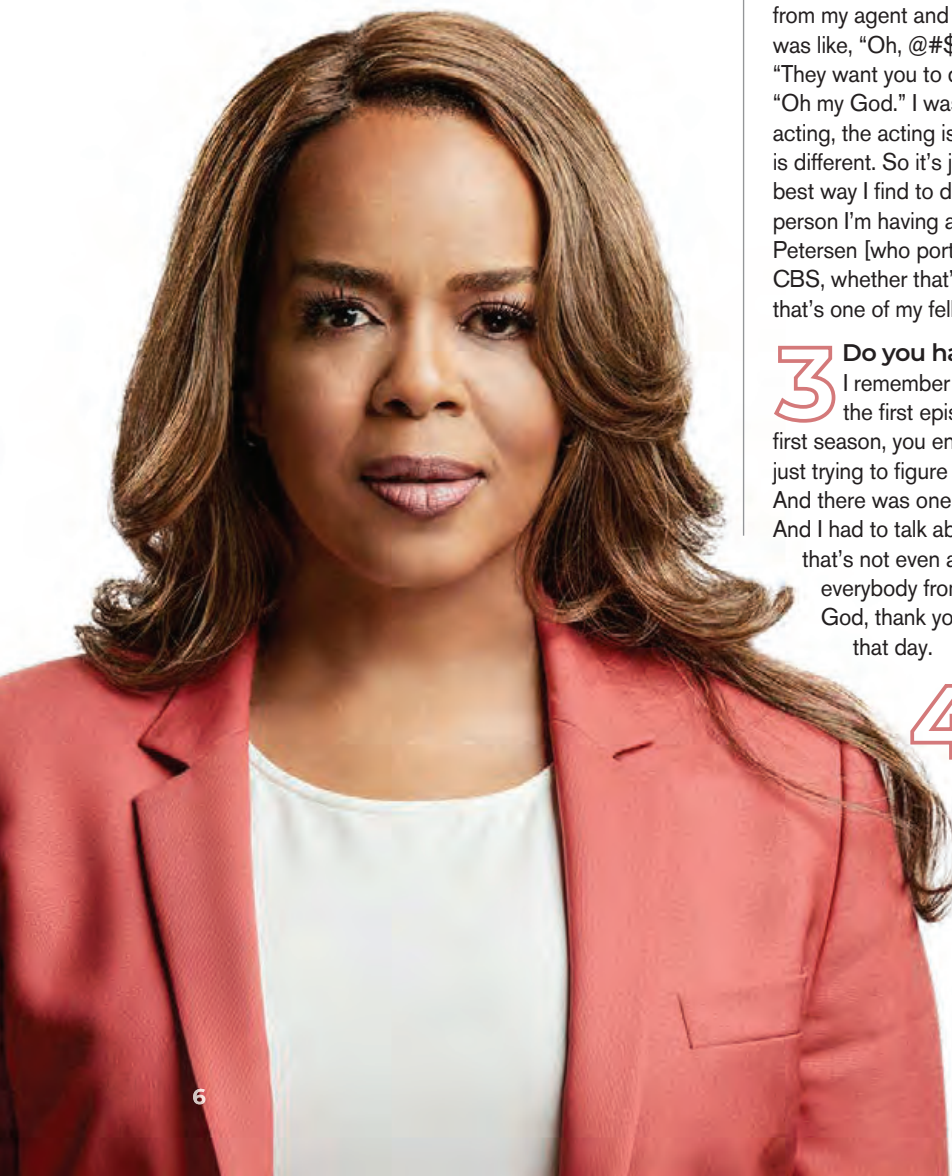

5 QUESTIONS WITH PAULA NEWSOME

The show that launched a thousand imitators is back, and it's ready to remind viewers that in the end, it's one of a kind. For more than a decade, *CSI: Crime Scene Investigation* (2000-15) was one of the most watched dramas in the world. Spawning three spinoffs (*Miami, NY* and *Cyber*), the franchise returns with *CSI: Vegas* (Wednesdays on CBS beginning Oct. 6). Leading the Vegas crime lab is Maxine (newcomer to the franchise Paula Newsome). Here she answers our "5 Questions."



1 Is Maxine out in the field with the cases or stuck behind a desk?

Both. Maxine's history, she was a basketball player at Northwestern University. And that's where she got her doctorate. Each scientist has something that is their specialty. Max's is genetics and kinesiology. But she also likes getting out in the field and getting her hands dirty.

2 What's it been like for you joining this huge franchise at this new moment?

I'll tell you what, so like any old L.A. actress, I'm coming out of a Pilates class. And I looked at my phone and there was a call from my agent and then a text from the head of the agency. And I was like, "Oh, @#\$%." ... And I called back, and they were like, "They want you to do *CSI*." And so in that moment, it was like, "Oh my God." I was a little overwhelmed. In terms of doing the acting, the acting is the same. The work is the same, the exposure is different. So it's just a matter of navigating the exposure. And the best way I find to do that is just to stay in a conversation with the person I'm having a conversation with. ... So whether that's Bill Petersen [who portrays Gil Grissom], whether that's the head of CBS, whether that's the guy who cleans out the trailers or whether that's one of my fellow actors.

3 Do you have any good stories from filming?

I remember it was me and Jorja [Fox] filming; I think it was the first episode. And the first episodes are always like the first season, you end up shooting a lot longer because everybody's just trying to figure out where the Post-its are. The days are longer. And there was one day that we were there until, I think, 3:30am. And I had to talk about single nucleotide polymorphisms. And that's not even all. [But] we did the scene in like two takes and everybody from the crew to the director were like, "Oh my God, thank you so much." Then we could all go home for that day.

4 What jobs did you work before becoming an actor?

Of course, I was a waiter for a period of time. I did a little telemarketing for like half an hour. I did singing telegrams. That was fun. You come in an outfit and with balloons and it's singing.

5 What TV shows are you watching right now?

I'm watching the show *Lupin*. It's a French television show online about Arsène Lupin. ... I don't use the subtitles – I speak French – but it's really, really, really neat.

RECENTLY RENEWED

HBO's recent buzzed-about limited series, the social satire **The White Lotus**, has been renewed for a second chapter that will feature new characters and locale. ... Over at Showtime, Bryan Cranston's new drama **Your Honor**, which broke Showtime viewing records with its debut, has been renewed for Season 2. The premium service is also bringing back new comedy **Flatbush Misdeemeanors** for Season 2, late-night talk show **Desus & Mero** for Season 4 and drama **The Chi** for Season 5. ... FX has renewed its hit vampire comedy **What We Do in the Shadows** for a fourth season. Meanwhile, Martin Freeman and Daisy Haggard will be back for Season 3 of the FX comedy **Breeders** in 2022. ... FOX is fetching a second season of its new pet-centric animated comedy **HouseBroken**, while cooking competition series **MasterChef** will return for Season 12 on the network. ... After wrapping production on Season 3, which is expected to air early next year, TNT's **Snowpiercer** was renewed for a fourth season. ... Before its series premiere in July, new Starz drama **Power Book III: Rising Kanan** was renewed for a second season. ... Ahead of the second season premiere of **Traficked With Mariana van Zeller** this December, Nat Geo renewed the Emmy-nominated docuseries for Season 3, which is expected to start filming this fall.

YANKED!: Recently Canceled Shows

NBC's plans for the **Ultimate Slip 'N Slide** competition series got flushed after an intestinal infection made several crew members ill and shut down production. ... The adventures of aardvark **Arthur** will end next year after 25 seasons on PBS. ... The wheels came off of HBO's skateboarder comedy **Betty** after two seasons. ... Everything stinks for the cast and crew

of Freeform's **Everything's Gonna Be Okay**. The comedy has been canceled after two seasons. ... Freeform's **Motherland: Fort Salem** will wrap up after its third season, likely coming next year. ... Bravo has no plans to bring back **The Real Housewives of Dallas** for a sixth season, but never say never. ... Netflix dropped the final season of **Dear White People** last month.

This four-part docuseries illuminates the veteran experience with a stunning, deeply moving range of stories from across the arc of American history, from the citizen-soldiers returning from the American Revolution to today's soldiers. Every voice featured in the program, from hosts to interviewees, is a veteran's. Episodes are presented by: TV host and former Marine Drew Carey (Episode 1); Iraq War Army veteran Sen. Tammy Duckworth (Episode 2); actor, Vietnam War veteran (National Guard) and Native American (Cherokee) activist Wes Studi (Episode 3); and actor, motivational speaker and Army veteran J.R. Martinez (Episode 4). "This show is really comprised of so many people," says series codirector/producer Leah Williams. "It represents all five branches, enlisted and officers. We have a range of jobs from those who worked as snipers, to cooks, to logistical specialists. We have people from all over the country. ... We wanted to have a good representation of women, African Americans, Latina community, Native Americans, Asian Americans, immigrants, people who represent the Muslim faith, LGBTQ representation and those with disabilities. ... We wanted to share some familiar stories, but also unfamiliar stories, as well, and some underrepresented voices, because we really felt like everyone's story deserved to be told."

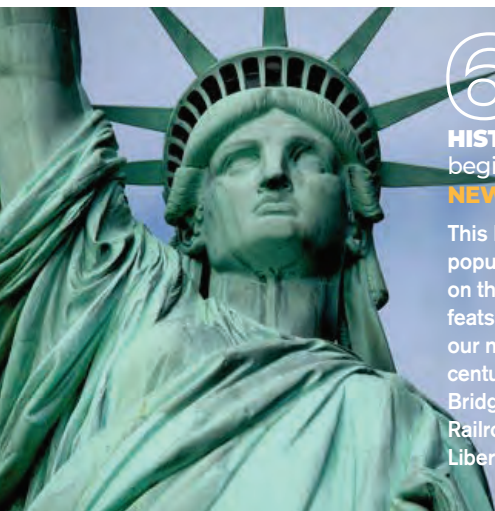

Heather Locklear Tears Up Talking About This Moving Story Of Love And Meaning. By Barb Oates

It's early September and Heather Locklear's got a lot going on. Her parents – Dad 92 and Mom 88 – are at the top of her priority list as she juggles their needs, while making time to talk about a project that is especially dear to her heart.

With a resumé that boasts plenty of iconic TV characters – *Melrose Place*'s Amanda Woodward, *Dynasty*'s Sammy Jo, *Spin City*'s Caitlin Moore, *T.J. Hooker*'s Officer Sheridan – Locklear now puts God and family and friends at the top of her priority list. When Locklear was given the script about bestselling author Dr. Richard Carlson, whose books have inspired and elevated the lives of millions (*Don't Sweat the Small Stuff* being one of them), and his writing partner and wife Kristine, she knew she wanted to be involved in sharing their story.

"I read the script, and I'm like, 'I love this,'" Locklear shares. "I want to do something that has to include God because I'm so God-driven. ... [During] the pandemic I didn't know if I wanted to act, I didn't know what I wanted to do. ... With *Don't Sweat the Small Stuff*, that book was out in the '90s. And it was a happy thing. It was a happy book. And it's so clear, so simple."

The Carlsons' bestselling self-help book series has helped so many people reduce stress and achieve happiness. The Lifetime original film *Don't Sweat the Small Stuff* dives more into the love story between Richard and Kristine and what happened after Richard's sudden death.

"I'm going to cry," Locklear says, reflecting on their story and playing Kristine. "I think it's special because we all meet people, but not all of us meet people who are our soulmates."

Kristine still has Richard's leather jacket hanging on the back of his chair in his home office. Her story is one of profound loss and strength in rebuilding her family and life. In addition to their love story, it's the message this couple shared and professed that Locklear hopes enriches others.

"It's so touching of what we all need to do. And I especially believe, because of what's going on, whether it be political, whether it be the environment, all of the changes that are going on, [the message is] just be present – be with your people, be with your animals, be with your Earth. ... We do stuff to make ourselves go further, make money, stuff that's really, in the end, not important. That rose to fruition to me. That's what it's all about."

Alan Ruck Brings Us Inside The Insanely Wealthy, Morally Bankrupt Roy Family. By Ryan A. Berenz

So that *Succession* Season 2 finale was crazy, huh? You should probably make sure you've seen it before reading the rest of this.

As the astronomically rich, ginormously powerful and majorly unscrupulous Roy family returns for Season 3, it's all-out war between Kendall (Jeremy Strong) and his father, Logan (Brian Cox). After Logan picked Kendall to take the fall for Waystar Royco's cruise-line scandal, Kendall instead told the world (and fed-up stockholders) that his father is "a malignant presence, a bully and a liar"

who knew all about the under-the-table settlements and coverups.

It's been two years since that episode dropped, and the COVID-19 pandemic was to blame for delaying the start of Season 3 production in New York until late 2020. Then the cast was off to very lovely but very hot Tuscany over the summer to film the season's final two episodes. "When you make a show about extremely wealthy people, you get to go to some very nice places," says Alan Ruck, who plays Connor, the eldest, oddest Roy sibling.

Fortunately for Connor, his complete disinterest in the family

business might shield him from the crossfire to come. "I think early on Connor realized he had no aptitude for the business world, so when the show is strictly dealing with problems of Waystar Royco, Connor is probably not going to be involved," Ruck says.

Connor's more into bankrolling his girlfriend's terrible Broadway play, bidding big money on fake Napoleon artifacts and running a ludicrous campaign for president of the United States. Those are the types of hobbies the Roy family can afford.

They also have the privilege of avoiding a global outbreak of a deadly disease, which is a concern of the great unwashed. Season 3 was written before the pandemic, and it made sense not to update the storylines to include it. "There are people in the world who kind of walk between the raindrops, and the Roys are a member of that group," Ruck says. "I do think that some — many, probably — of the world's wealthiest people were not affected by COVID in much of any way. Because it's like, 'Oh, this is annoying! We'll just go to our island, or that fabulous country home. We'll go wherever the disease isn't, in our private planes.'"

There's a merciless predator on the loose in Cape Cod. A highly potent drug called Great White is killing users and making dealers rich. In Season 2 of the gritty Starz crime drama *Hightown*, kingpin Frankie Cuevas (Amaury Nolasco) is out of prison, and he and his cousin, Jorge (new cast member Luis Guzmán), are determined to control the traffic. Cuevas is also tightening the screws on disgraced former cop Ray Abruzzo (James Badge Dale), and newly minted state police officer Jackie Quiñones (Monica Raymund) has a personal mission to bring Cuevas down. Meanwhile, Cuevas' enforcer Osito (Atkins Estimond) is wounded and incarcerated after his shootout with Quiñones. "I had all kinds of cars, guns, a beautiful girlfriend. I was making money," Estimond says of Osito. "Now flip that: I've lost it all, I'm injured, I'm vulnerable." But Osito might have a savior in the form of young, savvy drug dealer Charmaine (Imani Lewis), who wants to form a partnership. "After sifting through the tea leaves to see what her motivation was, he realizes she's legit," Estimond says. "She's very much like a little sister to him."

LIST OF A LIFETIME

Lifetime Honors Breast Cancer Awareness With A Tale Of A Mother And Daughter. By Taylor Neumann

In addition to creating compelling and often timely original films, Lifetime also commits itself to bringing awareness to various women's issues. This month the network is focusing on breast cancer – it is Breast Cancer Awareness Month – the most common cancer around the world. Along with these efforts is the premiere of a new film, *List of a Lifetime*. The movie focuses on a mother and daughter, and it really emphasizes the enduring power of love.

Kelly Hu, who plays Brenda Lee, the mother, explains the film further. “The mother gets diagnosed with an aggressive form of breast cancer and realizes that she carries this breast cancer gene – the BRCA1 gene – and she gave up her daughter for adoption 23 years before, has never been in contact with her, and she decides that she needs to go and find her and warn her about this gene so she can get checked and save herself. And then through this connection, reconnecting, they build a relationship.” After Brenda finds her daughter, Talia (played by Sylvia Kwan), the two bond over creating a bucket list for Brenda to complete.

Kwan was excited to be a part of such an important film. “I think it’s wonderful to be able to bring awareness to this cause on such a large scale,” she elaborated. “And also, I really love the idea of living your life the way you want to, whether it’s creating a bucket list and doing all the things you want to do, or whether it’s questioning what kind of person you want to be and what kind of relationships you want to have.”

So what’s on their individual bucket lists? Kwan has some ambitious ideas. “One of my top ones is backpacking the Chilkoot Trail in Alaska. I want to visit Patagonia and travel a lot more. I want to go skydiving. I want to get scuba certified. There are a lot of things – a lot of adventurous things – but I think this film also made me think about other things that are not so stereotypical for a bucket list. What are certain things that I would like to accomplish before my time on Earth is up? It was really interesting to think about just because this film brought up a lot of these questions.”

And what about Hu? “I’ve had a bucket list since I was in my late teens, I think. My list is forever ... it’s always evolving, and it’s pages and

pages long. ... I’ve been fortunate enough to knock a lot of things off my bucket list, like hiking Machu Picchu, and going to India, and having vodka and caviar in Russia. [But] one of the things that’s on my bucket list is to save a life, so I became a donor.”

Hu also has a personal connection to the film and its themes. “My mother was diagnosed [with breast cancer] when I was 8 or 9. I remember that being the first time I ever realized my mother’s mortality, when she got diagnosed, because she had a whole conversation with my brother and I should she not come out of this, like who we would end up having to live with, and it was really, I think, one of the most traumatic things for us to go through as kids of somebody going through this diagnosis.” Her mother survived, but later in life, her grandmother also contracted the disease. “I got tested a long time ago for the BRCA gene, and thank goodness I don’t have it, but it’s still something that can occur. So I’m still very careful, very mindful.”

List of a Lifetime is a great film to watch with your mother (or your daughter) and reminds viewers not only to mind their physical health but also to be honest with themselves about the kind of love they accept in their lives.

[The cast and crew] really were like a family, I’m telling you. We even hung out.” *List of a Lifetime* also fell under Lifetime’s Broader Focus initiative, championing women in key production roles.

MORE REIMAGINED '80s HORROR ON SYFY

"Day Of The Dead" Series And "Slumber Party Massacre" Movie Part Of Lineup. By Jeff Pfeiffer

Syfy and USA Network's *Chucky* series (see main feature in this spread) is reimagining an '80s horror icon, but it's not the only way that Syfy is drawing from classic terror tales of that decade to freak out modern audiences this month. The network is also debuting *Day of the Dead*, a series inspired by George A. Romero's 1985 film of the same name, which was the third film in his *Night of the Living Dead* series; and the original film *Slumber Party Massacre*, a modern reimagining of the infamous 1982 slasher film.

The 10-episode *Day of the Dead* follows six strangers as they try to survive the first 24 hours of an undead invasion. They'll quickly learn that sometimes all it takes to bring people together is a horde of hungry zombies trying to rip them apart.

The plot for *Slumber Party Massacre* sounds as similarly simple as its source material: The titular get-together turns into a bloodbath as a psycho wielding a power drill disrupts the fun. The 1982 movie was a rarity at its time as a slasher film written and directed by women (Rita Mae Brown and Amy Holden Jones, respectively). Brown's original script was a slasher parody that was turned more serious against her wishes, though the movie retained some humor and feminist elements that have helped it stand out a bit from the legions of similar films in that era and remain a cult classic that has even garnered some positive critical reviews.

Similarly, this remake features women in two top behind-the-scenes creative roles — it was written by Suzanne Keilly (*Ash vs Evil Dead*) and directed by Danishka Esterhazy (*The Banana Splits Movie*, several episodes of Syfy's new *SurrealEstate* series). Esterhazy is known for her female-driven stories and seems likely to add some twists to the slasher film genre.

Doctor Convicted Of Murdering His Beauty Queen Wife

Lifetime partners with legal journalist, author and crime-stopper baddie Nancy Grace to tell the story of Martin MacNeill, a Utah doctor convicted of murdering his beauty queen wife Michelle in 2007. The widely publicized story made national headlines when it was found out that the good doctor's entire

career was based on falsified transcripts to get into medical school and how he deceived the military to collect benefits. The original film *The Good Father: The Martin MacNeill Story* premieres on Lifetime Saturday, Oct. 2, and stars Tom Everett Scott and Charisma Carpenter.

“City Confidential” Returns To The A&E Lineup

A&E continues to focus its attention on the crime genre with new episodes of *Court Cam* (Fridays) as well as the network's returning one-hour series *City Confidential* (Thursdays beginning Oct. 28). *City Confidential* originally premiered on A&E in 1998 and ran for 11 seasons before being canceled in 2005. The docuseries follows one crime, the ensuing evidence and the impact that crime has on a community. Speaking with family, friends, detectives,

journalists and others close to the case, the series weaves together firsthand accounts and archival footage to explore the crime and its outcome. From a reclusive Amish farming community to a college campus in Washington, D.C., to an upscale shopping district in Houston, the series travels across the country to examine a variety of cases, the history of the community and how these crimes had lasting effects on the local citizens.

America's Most Sadistic Serial Killer Talks



Oxygen turns its attention to one of America's most sadistic serial killers. Over a period of five months in 1979 Southern California, using instruments like pliers, ice picks and sledgehammers, Roy Lewis Norris and Lawrence Bittaker (known as the Toolbox Killers) raped, tortured and killed five teenage

girls. In the two-hour documentary *The Toolbox Killer* (Sunday, Oct. 3), Bittaker describes his 1979 killing spree. He was originally silent about his crimes for 40 years, until he met investigator Laura Brand. Over the course of five years, Brand recorded her many conversations with Bittaker as he spoke from death row about his methods and motives, providing unique insights into the mind of a criminal sadist.

“I Remember: Daddy Did It”

Showtime examines one of the pioneering legal cases of repressed memory in the network's new four-part docuseries *Buried* (Sunday, Oct. 10). The series follows the gripping story of Eileen Franklin, who, while playing with her young daughter, suddenly had a memory of witnessing the rape and murder of her childhood best friend, 8-year-old Susan Nason, which led to a re-opening of a case that had gone unsolved for nearly 20 years. And

in a shocking twist, when Eileen came forward with her memory, she told the police that she remembered the murderer was her own father, George Franklin. The docuseries reveals the consequences of that fateful assertion of the subconscious and the infinite questions it sparked about the accuracy and reliability of unearthing traumatic events in the court of law. Through riveting first-person testimonials of family, neighbors, memory experts, law enforcement, mental health professionals and many others, *Buried* explores the impact of Eileen's memory on not only the Franklin family but also on the legal and mental health communities writ large.

Arkansas' River Valley Killer Exposed

In the two-hour special episode *Snapped Notorious: River Valley Killer* (Saturday,

Oct. 9 on Oxygen), cameras revisit the quiet community of Fort Smith, Arkansas, where a deranged necrophiliac who targeted elderly and vulnerable women preyed. Known as the River Valley Killer, he brutally murdered and raped two elderly women in 1993 and 1995, and in 2000 tried the same on a 16-year-old girl, but was caught by her stepfather.

Happy Face Killer Exposed

During the early 1990s, the man known as the Happy Face Killer viciously strangled eight women and dumped their bodies along the road. *New York Times* bestselling author and crime novelist M. William Phelps shares rare on-camera interviews and never-before-heard chilling recordings with the psychopathic killer in the two-hour special *Snapped Notorious: Happy Face Killer* (Sunday, Oct. 10 on Oxygen). Phelps and

the Happy Face Killer were in correspondence for years while Phelps was working on a TV show; he later penned a book, *Dangerous Ground: My Friendship With a Serial Killer*, about his conversations.

Murdered And Missing In Montana

Imagine a place where your daughter goes missing and your cries for help may not be heard. A place where Indigenous women are murdered at 10 times the rate of any other ethnic group and killers are rarely brought to justice. In Oxygen's two-hour documentary special *Murdered and Missing in Montana* (Sunday, Oct. 17), attorney and investigative journalist Loni Coombs focuses on the cases of three young, Indigenous women whose deaths on and around the Northern Cheyenne and Crow Reservations remain a mystery.

Jena Friedman Looks Beyond Whodunit

SundanceTV announced in late summer that the network was expanding its coverage in the true crime genre, and was adding *True Crime Story: Indefensible* to its lineup beginning Thursday, Oct. 14. Over six 30-minute episodes, host Jena Friedman (*The Daily Show*) travels the country to unspool real cases on the ground, but unlike most true crime shows, this one doesn't end when the criminal gets locked up. Friedman finds there's always more to the story and drives to a different outcome beyond the simple whodunit. Using her unflinching comedic point of view and disarming interview skills, Friedman uncovers the “why” and “how” not only of crimes themselves, but also of our sometimes dysfunctional criminal justice system. “Many Americans don't think about our criminal justice system until they're in it,” Friedman says. “I hope this show gives viewers insight into some of the ways in which the system is flawed, so at the very least, they'll be a little more prepared in the event they ever end up on a jury.”



CATCH SOME RAYS

Contenders Soak Up The Shot To Shine In MLB's Postseason Spotlight. By Ryan A. Berenz

It wasn't quite how the L.A. Dodgers and their fans dreamed of winning their first World Series title since 1988, but a championship is a championship.

Last October, under the cloud of COVID-19, the Dodgers beat the Tampa Bay Rays in six games in front of a sparse, socially distanced crowd at neutral Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas.

After returning to the 162-game regular-season grind in 2021, expect this postseason to offer something closer to pre-pandemic levels of excitement as teams return to playing in their own ballparks at max capacity. The playoffs also return to their traditional format, with 10 teams – three division winners and two wild-card entrants in each league – still eligible to book a trip to the Fall Classic.

In the American League, the Tampa Bay Rays are primed to return to the World Series. Standing in the Rays' way are the Chicago White Sox and Houston Astros, along with a formidable trio of wild-card hopefuls in the N.Y. Yankees, Boston Red Sox and Oakland A's.

The Senior Circuit has the Dodgers and the surprising San Francisco Giants as frontrunners in the National League West. The Atlanta Braves have a handle on the East for the fourth straight season, while the Milwaukee Brewers are tops in the Central. Teams hoping to sneak into the playoffs via the wild-card route include the Cincinnati Reds, San Diego Padres and Philadelphia Phillies.

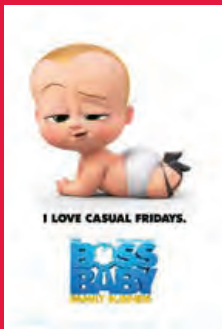

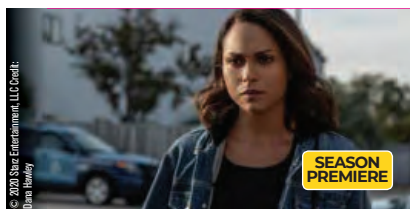

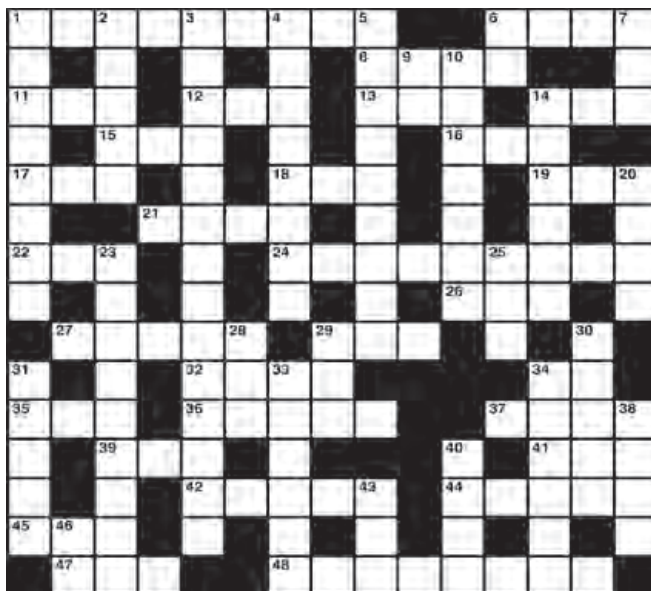
